  - a. **Appoint Chair & Co-Chair** Motion by Jacob Thompson to appoint Donald Poole as Chair and Pam Alley as Co-Chair. Second by Leslie Dyer. Vote 3/0/2 Donald and Pam abstained. Motion carried.

- 7. Committee and Department Reports/Appointments
  - **a.** Accept & Appropriate Donations Motion by Eric Gasperini to accept and appropriate donations. Second by Jake Thompson. Vote 5/0/0. Motion carried.
  - b. Road Commissioner The Board reviewed the report. Pam asked if the crew would be able to pick up trash from town parks (Quarries) if cans were put out. Andy said they pick up on Main Street at least a couple times a week and would ask if they could add the parks/quarries.
  - c. Engineer Report/Updates The Engineers are meeting with the Water District tomorrow and with the Fishermen's Co-op next week (July 21) about the Downtown Project. Meeting with the Engineers today to discuss Vinal Cove Culvert assessment and possible grant opportunities. Andy will also be meeting with them to sign a work order for the Transfer Station.
  - d. Knox County Sheriff Report Andy compiled a total from the last six months of the Vinalhaven calls to Knox County.

  - a. Bingo/Beano Approval Letter Woodcock, Cassie, Coombs Post 18 Motion by Jake Thompson to sign the blanket authorization for Woodcock, Cassie, Coombs Legion Post #18 to

- b. Selectmen Goals/Workplan finalize FY 22 goals Goals for Selectmen: Focus on grants for Downtown Project, a transition plan for employees (retirements/resignations), Housing, Transfer Station, Vinal Cove, Air Strip extension, Professional review of Land Use Ordinance, require a quorum for Annual Town Meeting, and audit of Conservation/Tree Growth/Open Space lands.
- c. Surplus Equipment There is equipment that will not be being brought to the new Public Works garage. Motion by Eric Gasperini to authorize Dan Bickford and Andy Dorr to offer equipment first to Mad Man Marine at their discretion. Second by Pam Alley. Vote 5/0/0. Motion carried.
- d. Remote Meetings Policy The Board reviewed a first draft of a Remote Board Meetings policy. There was discussion on continuing meetings virtually, and the issues with making all documents accessible for those attending virtually. There was a consensus of the Board to have documents for anything being presented to the Selectboard in to the Town Office by close of business on Monday (or day prior to the Selectboard meeting). For general business, information should be at the Town Office by the close of business Thursday (before the meeting) to be included in Selectmen's packets. Donald asked if being out of state for work, or when Jake is on vacation in March would be included under "temporary absence." Andy will get clarification.
- e. Septic Waste Disposal Facility Agreement Motion by Pam Alley to authorize the Town Manager to sign the Septic Waste Disposal Facility Agreement on behalf of the Board of Selectmen. Second by Jake Thompson. Vote 5/0/0. Motion carried.
- f. LRAP Motion by Eric Gasperini to authorize the Town Manager to sign the LRAP on behalf of the Board of Selectmen. Second by Donald Poole. Vote 5/0/0. Motion carried.
- 10. Report of Town Manager The board reviewed Andy's memo. There was discussion on ARPA funds being earmarked already. Andy has drafted a memo to the Knox County Commissioners requesting the county hold on authorizing any further funds.

## 11. Report of Members

- a. Eric mentioned visibility issues around the Atlantic Ave, Water Street, and Leo's Lane intersection. There is a garden that is covering the sidewalk on Water Street and a tree blocking visibility when exiting Leo's Lane. Leslie said there are bushes when exiting the Medical Center Loop that should also be taken back. There was a consensus to reach out to land owners regarding these concerns.
- b. Donald asked if the "Hidden Drive" signs recently placed on Pequot Road could be moved slightly. They are now blocking visibility when exiting Ocean View Drive.
