Request an Absentee Ballot

Registered Vinalhaven Voters may request absentee ballots any **ONE** of three ways:

- Use the Secretary of State's Online Absentee Ballot Request Portal.
 Go to apps.web.maine.gov/cgibin/online/AbsenteeBallot/index.
 pl The deadline to request ballots using this service is 5:00 pm on Thursday, October 29, 2020.
- Call the Town Office at (207) 863-4343 to request a ballot by phone. Please Note: the person requesting the ballot must speak with the Clerk. A person may not request a ballot for someone other than themselves.
- Print, fill out and mail (or put in our drop box) the request form available on the Town website. www.townofvinalhaven.org

Actual ballots will be mailed 30 days prior to the election.

You will need to fill out a Maine Voter Registration Card and provide a Maine Drivers License or Maine ID AND proof of Vinalhaven residence (if your VH address is not already on the license).

Reading Online Wind on a Kindle

- Download the wind to your computer/device
- 2. Create an email message addressed to your Kindle account
- 3. Subject of the email is the word "Convert"
- 4. Attach the wind PDF to the email body (no other text)
- 5. Send email
- After a short while open your Kindle app and synchronize the Wind should appear in your library!


To find the Kindle email account mentioned above, you need to open the Kindle app and go to 'App Settings' in your menu at Kindle's home page. It lists 'Send to Kindle Email Address' - copy/paste that address and you're all set.

When I was a young boy my father would rise with the sun. Part of His Saturday morning ritual was to tend his substantial vegetable garden. By noon the Bear (Dad) would be caked in mud and sweat. Satisfied With his finished task he poured a pint of Mom's homemade iced tea, grabbed his expensive Sony radio and sat in his favourite Adirondack deck chair. At 1 PM, like clockwork, he tuned his AM-FM to NPR's "Saturday Afternoon at the Met". When the Opera began you could tell this music affected him. With his eyes closed his head would sway to the passion of the Voices. He was at peace and allowed his senses to open wide to absorb every note. Sometimes he would join Caruso or Pavarotti on his mind's stage and sing along with the Devo's..............

When I was a young man living in -Nyack on the Hudson - as I lay in my bed enjoying the birds weaving their morning song something unexpected entered the blend. Entangled in their morning verse drifted a hauntingly beautiful aria. I closed my eyes and let this new musical thread encase me in its melody. It was lightness somewhere between sleep and wake, drifting between the music of nature and its voices...Thinking if I opened my eyes it would all go away......

When the Aria was over, I looked down from my bedroom window to find it's the origin. In my neighbours' flower garden, amongst its splendour sat an obsolete RCA Victor wind up gramophone. I quickly dressed and hurried next door to try to discover what exactly I had just heard. My neighbours, a charming elderly couple greeted me at their gate. They were pleased that I enjoyed their musical selection and told me the diva's name was Magda Olivero, the piece was Leo Delibes "The Flower Duet". I told them it was the first time this delicate type of music moved me, and it was perfect morning garden music........

Today I was driving my car listening to Audie Cornish on NPR; She began her narrative with "The Opera World lost one of its most enduring Diva's, Magda Olivero at the age of 104". Audie then played snippets of her 70-year stage repertoire. Goosebumps ran down my arms and neck as memories of my 1980 meeting with her voice flooded my mind. This second chance encounter with her verse made me pull the car over to listen......as I couldn't find her rendition of this Aria by Miss Olivero on YouTube, this elegant composition will stir your emotions

Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

Happy Rainy Monday!

The big celestial show of Wednesday afternoon between the hours of 3:30 and 4:30 found many Vinalhavenites looking upward. Although not in the zone of totality the scene was mighty interesting. Owing to the crescent of light, observers did not get the corona effect, but it was a fine show. Only light fleecy clouds passed over at the height of the shadow but did not shut off the view. Through glass and films it appeared almost transparent. A weird light spread over the earth and lasted some time, similar to moonlight. Then at the sunset hour the spectacle was unusual and very beautiful. After all, island people were favored more than many who sought areas of totality.

Courier-Gazette August 31, 1932

On May 3-4 a Tonsil Clinic was conducted in Vinalhaven under the auspices of the Vinalhaven Community Health Council in cooperation with the health councils of North Haven and Matinicus. Twenty children from Vinalhaven, two from Matinicus and two from North haven, previously screened by the school physician and public health nurse, were operated on by Dr. Paul Millington assisted by Dr. Ralph P. Earle, Marjorie Roscoe, PHN; Rebecca Bruce, RN; Evelyn Kelwick, RN; and ladies of the Vinalhaven Health Council. Patricia Skoog, Elizabeth Davidson, Frances

Gilchrest and Eleanor Conway assisted in surgery with anesthesia and instruments. Hazel Roberts, Grace Peterson, Joyce Ames, Helen Webb and Ethel Wooster, of North Haven assisted in the wards during the day. Dorothy Warren, Winona Peterson, Bessie Geary, Muriel Osgood and Ethel Wooster assisted in the wards during the night. The patients were kept in overnight in the twelve-bed ward of the Island Community Medical Services, Inc., which was covered at all times by a doctor or registered nurse.



Adapted from Mark Bittman's How to Cook Everything


Ingredients

2 tbsps Dijon mustard
2 tbsps sherry or balsamic vinegar
1 tbsp sugar
1/2 cup olive, peanut or vegetable oil
6 cups cored and shredded cabbage
1 cup diced scallions or 1/2 cup finely chopped onions
Salt and pepper




