

COMPOSTING

Vinalhaven Community Compost at the Transfer Station



Yes FOOD SCRAPS

vegtables, fruit, peels, grains, coffee grounds eggshells, fish, spoiled and leftover foods

UNCOATED FOOD PAPERS

tea bags, coffee filters, soiled napkins



No X MEAT, BONES, DAIRY

no meats and dairy, no large quantities of oil

COMPOSTABLE "PLASTICS"

no bags/pail liners, no cups, no cutlery


PRODUCE STICKERS

How VH Community Compost Works

- 1. Collect food scraps at home and at work
- 2. Dump food scraps into the collection bin at the Transfer Station
- 3. We mix all the food scraps into an active manure pile
- 4. The pile cures until it becomes nutrient-rich compost
- 5. Our community uses the compost to enrich garden soils

6:00 a.m. I walk into the kitchen to get a cup of coffee. I see the binoculars on the table and decide to look. I get them up to my eyes and immediately the female wood duck flies directly into the duck house. What luck is that??

Yesterday there was a dispute between a couple male wood ducks. There was also a female there. This morning there were three males and one female in the yard and two males in the water. How many are there? Wouldn't it be wonderful to have two houses with babies.

We haven't had anything unusual so far, but it's wonderful to see herons and a kingfisher fishing. The mallards are fewer, but we have a pair who come into the yard for corn. I know she must be sitting on eggs and hope she brings the babies up. They get so tame they don't listen to their mother and come waddling up as soon as they know I'm bringing corn. They were in there all summer last year and it was fun to watch them grow.

I've seen a tree creeper and there are chicks, nuthatches, gold finches, juncos, white throated sparrows, blue jays, and a pair of cardinals in the feeder and hairy and downy woodpeckers on the suet.

Go for a walk in the woods and listen to the birds singing and the frogs peeping and the chaotic world of right now fades away. C.D.


Water District Flushing Notice




