- When approaching the building, please *maintain a minimum distance of six feet from other individuals and wear a mask.*
- Please return materials to the book drops at front and rear of the building.
- Returned materials undergo a quarantine period before being checked back into our circulation system, so our online catalog may be up to a week out-of-date. To ensure availability of an item, please call or email.

- Due to quarantine requirements and to make it possible for the maximum number of people to access these materials, **only 2 new release titles per patron** may be checked out for a period of 7 days.
- Patrons may borrow up to 2 more new release titles when the first returned titles have been quarantined and entered back into circulation.
- No renewals allowed.

Vinalhaven School News

As we quickly move into August, almost every wants to know the plans for Vinalhaven School. Yes, we're having school, and yes, we'll be sharing extensive information in the coming weeks. Here's what you can expect:

- All schools in the state of Maine will have at least 3 plans. Plan A.) All students are at school in the building. Plan B.) "Hybrid" means that students are at school part of the time, and "remote" part of the time. Plan C.) All students are remote (not in the building). We will be prepared with all plans required by the state. And, with each plan, our goal is to make school engaging, relevant, and fun.
- 2. Vinalhaven has significant advantages because we have smaller class sizes, lots of outdoor space, and a large building with great ventilation. Plus, teachers who are willing

to put all of these plans together during the summer!

- 3. When we compete our planning, we'll get that info out to the community. It will be on our website, on our facebook page, shared through community links, and we'll produce a video where we can "walk" through the school to show everyone how it will work.
- 4. We will have repeated "zoom" sessions where we'll explain the plans, and then invite everyone in the community to ask questions.
- 5. Even though we will share with you each plan, we will not know which plan the state will require us to use on September 8 when school starts. No matter what, we will consistently communicate updates with the Vinalhaven community!

Veggie Conner: Greek Fisherman's Stew

Adapted from Florence Fabricant's recipe in the NY Times. Serves 6.

- ✓ 3 tbsps olive oil
- ✓ 1 medium onion, diced
- ✓ 6 cloves garlic, sliced thin
- ✓ 1 small head fennel, diced
- ✓ 1/4 red chili flakes
- ✓ 3 large tomatoes
- ✓ Salt
- ✓ 1 cup dry white wine
- 1/2 lb. potatoes, peeled and diced
- ✓ Black pepper
- Lemon juice
- ✓ 2 lbs halibut, cut into 12 pieces
- ✓ 6 basil leaves, torn
- Mayonnaise seasoned with 1 1/2 tsps sriracha or other hot sauce

1.) Warm oil in a 4 qt saucepan over medium heat. Stir in onion and garlic and cook until soft but not brown. Add fennel and cook a few minutes, until softened. Stir in chili flakes. Add tomatoes and salt, cover and cook on medium for about 10 minutes.

2.) Stir in wine and 2 1/2 cups of water, bring to a simmer, until potatoes are tender. check seasonings, adding salt and pepper to taste. Add lemon juice.

3.) Season fish pieces with salt and pepper, place them in the stew and simmer on low, covered, until the fish is just cooked through, about 5 minutes. Meanwhile, warm 6 generous soup plates.

4.) When fish is done, remove it to the warm soup plates. Remove pot from heat, stir in basil, just to wilt it and divide soup among the 6 plates. Serve spiced mayonnaise on the side if desired.



Reading Online Wind on a Kindle

Norbert Leser shared his steps for converting the online Wind into a more easily readable version on a Kindle.

- 1. Download the wind to your computer/device
- 2. Create an email message addressed to your Kindle account
- Subject of the email is the word "Convert"
- 4. Attach the wind PDF to the email body (no other text)
- 5. Send email
- After a short while open your Kindle app and synchronize - the Wind should appear in your library!

To find the Kindle email account mentioned above, you need to open the Kindle app and go to 'App Settings' in your menu at Kindle's home page. It lists 'Send to Kindle Email Address' - copy/ paste that address and you're all set.



THE OBSERVER Kevin Waters was a big man, and his heart was proportional to his size. A few years ago, Vinalhaven opened its own heart to Kevin, trying to emulate his own compassionate regard for we who have depended on him and on Penobscot Island Air for so long. It was an evening of entertainment, a roast essentially, at the auditorium, during which Kevin had to sacrifice a night at home and sit centerstage so one after another of us could have fun at his expense. But his capacity for taking as much abuse as we could give was as big as his capacity for giving all that we could take—all the love and compassion we could take—and we have certainly taken. He once made a special flight so an island man in a hard place could enjoy a birthday cake a loved one had ordered for him. Not unusual. And if there any possible way he could get a plane out here in an emergency, he did. Kevin was in our corner and nearly all of us, at one time or another, is better off as a result. pc



Historical Notes from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

<u>Vinalhaven Echo August 9, 1888</u>

Singular Mystery: For skeptics to unravel

Friday of the past week excitement prevailed here. More than two hundred people gazed in amazement and wonder upon a scene that was awe inspiring. It was a large wreath of smoke crossing the water from Lane's Island to Norton's Point apparently coming from out of the water. All the people at the Sands looked in vain to see what mysterious agency produced it, but nothing could be seen but the smoke rising as though coming from a steamboat's smokestack. Its mystical appearance and origin so excited many that they took to boats and rowed out to it to ascertain and unravel its invisible origin, but there was nothing to be seen but the watery exhalations of visible vapor curling up into the heavens and vanishing into obscurity leaving the explorers more mystified than ever and destitute of understanding its obscure mystery. It looks monstrously absurd to believe that occult powers are at work in this vicinity, but many of the people who saw the phenomenon believe in the direct agency of supernatural powers and say it is a premonition of something awful to come.

Vinalhaven, August 22, 1916

A shark measuring 10'4" was caught near Green's Island by Capt. Walter Tolman of the sloop "Lelia E." The shark was entangled in the fishing trawl and was secured after much effort and brought to Vinalhaven, where it has been attracting much attention.

Vinalhaven, May 16, 1929

The attraction of the week was the arrival of a seaplane Wednesday afternoon from Rockland with Pilot Wincapaw. The following availed themselves of the opportunity to receive the first thrill of an air flight: Flavilla Arey, Pauline Sanborn, Lida Greenlaw, Fred Chilles, Frank Winslow, O. V. Drew, G. C. Peasley, George Elwell, Fred Geary, George Wright, Frank Oakes, Henry Anderson, Carl Magnuson, Oscar Columb, Freeman Robinson. They flew over the adjacent islands, including North Haven and the Morrow Estate where the Lindbergh-Morrow wedding will take place. I was some trip!
