## State and Local Elections For Tuesday, July 14, 2020 Vinalhaven Town Office

For Vinalhaven, in-person voting will take place on **July 14** at the **Town Office**, 19 Washington School Road.
This location will be open **8am** – **8pm**.

To minimize interaction with others during this public health pandemic (COVID-19), voters are encouraged to cast an absentee ballot instead of voting in person. Casting an absentee ballot is convenient and secure.

## How do I request an absentee ballot?

- 1. In writing
- Phone call your Municipal Clerk's office at 207-863-4343
- Online from the Secretary of State's website: www1.maine.gov/cgibin/online/AbsenteeBallot/online-form.pl
- 4. <u>In person</u> up to and including the day of the election

Please allow for 2-5 days to receive and send your ballot.

Absentee ballot requests are being accepted right now. Printed ballots will be available by mid-June, and we will issue your ballot as soon as possible after that date.

Ballots must be returned to the municipal clerk no later than 8pm on Election Day.

This includes ALL Motor Vehicles, ATV's, Watercraft, Snowmobiles and Trailers



## **How to Register a Vehicle**

Re-registering a vehicle previously registered in Vinalhaven Provide current proof of insurance on the vehicle (not past or future cards—it has to be effective on the date of registration), and current mileage of the vehicle. Please call for amount due.

Re-registering a vehicle that has been registered in Maine, but never registered in Vinalhaven:

Provide a **copy of the most recent registration**, **current proof of insurance** (as listed above) and **current mileage** of the vehicle. Please call for amount due.



Provide **proof of insurance** (as listed above), **current mileage** of the vehicle, a **sales invoice** that shows sales tax was paid, and the **blue title application** are needed. Please call for amount due.

## Registering a new (or used) vehicle from a private sale:

Provide **current proof of insurance** (as listed above), **current mileage** of the vehicle, a **bill of sale**, and the **original title signed over to you** (if the vehicle is 1995 or newer). \*Please Note\* You CANNOT sell a vehicle that is 1995 or newer until you have received a title for it in YOUR NAME. You do not need to register the vehicle, but you do need to get the new title. Please call for amount due.

## If you need to file a SR-22:

Please call for amount due for Excise Tax only. Forms will need to be taken to a Maine Bureau of Motor Vehicle Branch Office to complete your registration and receive your stickers.



## <u>How to Register Your Boat, Snowmobile or ATV</u>

Re-registering a vehicle previously registered in Vinalhaven:

Provide the **registration number** (5 letters/numbers) and **vehicle information** for boat, snowmobile or ATV you wish to re-register. Please call for amount due.

Registering a New Boat, Snowmobile or ATV:
Provide proof that sales tax was paid or bill of sale
listing sales price, hull or vehicle serial number, and
vehicle information (horsepower, length of boat,
make, and model). Please call for amount due.

- Download the wind to your computer/device
- 2. Create an email message addressed to your Kindle account
- 3. Subject of the email is the word "Convert"
- 4. Attach the wind PDF to the email body (no other text)
- 5. Send email
- After a short while open your Kindle app and synchronize - the Wind should appear in your library!

To find the Kindle email account mentioned above, you need to open the Kindle app and go to 'App Settings' in your menu at Kindle's home page. It lists 'Send to Kindle Email Address' - copy/paste that address and you're all set.



## Self Guided Warbler Walk

## **Lady Slippers on Huber Preserve**

These very special orchids will start blooming very soon. They can be found in many places on the island, but MCHT's Huber Preserve has an impressive growth of lady slippers.

Once blooming, lady slippers are not hard to find. The large pink, slipper-like bloom is beautiful and unique. Because they take so long to grow into mature plants, picking or digging them is not allowed. Enjoy them while they are out!

To get to Huber Preserve from the ferry, go left on Sands Road for .4 miles, then right on Old Harbor Road for .3 miles, then bearing slightly left onto North Haven Road for 1.7 miles, turn right onto Round the Island Road. The parking area is on the left in 1.6 miles.

## Effective May 21, 2020:

The Maine State Ferry Service will return to the regular Summer Schedule between Rockland and Vinalhaven.

Please note that the Governor Curtis is scheduled to fill in for the Thompson while it is in the shipyard for maintenance starting 5/21. Please remember that only 5 people are permitted in the cabins at one time and to practice safe social distancing.



## Announcement by the Maine State Ferry Service:

The current Standby System at the Vinalhaven Ferry Terminal will no longer be in effect as of Monday, June 1, 2020.

From that date forward, the Vinalhaven Terminal will operate the same as other MSFS terminals for standby status:

Vehicles may line up 1 hour before the first departure of the day, and for all other departures, vehicles may line up once the previous boat has departed.

When vehicles get in line, they must plan to depart on the next boat.

Vehicles will be directed to board the ferry on a first come, first serve basis.

Standby numbers attached to Line Numbers are also no longer in effect from June 1, 2020.

The First Come, First Serve Standby starting point will remain the same, and will continue down to the end of the guardrail/entrance of the upper parking lot.

The beginning and end of the standby line will be clearly marked, and all vehicles lined up must fit completely with in the lines.

## **Star of Hope Update**



Our effort to stabilize the Star of Hope building was halted in mid-March and therefore, the scaffolding is still on the building. While this work was on-hold, we were able to achieve some other important business in preparation of our strategic planning effort.

We are pleased to announce that the construction crew will be returning to Vinalhaven on June 1<sup>st</sup> to continue their work, strictly following the COVID-19 guidelines of the CDC and State. We are committed to ensuring the safety of our workers and the residents of Vinalhaven. We will:




