

12-18-2020 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC) COVID-19 UPDATE

The state is continuing to see record high daily totals of positive cases primarily due to community spread originating in small gatherings. Please be careful and cautious regarding how you choose to celebrate December holidays. Don't take risks. Avoid unnecessary in-person get-togethers, and if you don't have to travel, please stay home.

State Updates

As of December 18, 2020 there were 7,312 active cases reported in the state (an increase of 2,800 cases since our 12-11-20 update) and 18,337 total cumulative cases statewide. Currently there are 100 active cases in Knox county. The state's positivity rate is 4.43%. See COVID-19 data on the Knox Hub website knox-hub-knoxme.hub.arcgis. com

As of December, 17, 2020, 2,264 high-risk individuals, primarily front-line healthcare workers, received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Beginning Monday, certain skilled nursing facilities in Maine will receive their first shipment of the vaccine. Sometime within the next few weeks, Vinalhaven EMS is expecting to receive enough vaccine for our first responders.
