#### 1. Ordinance Revisions/Updates

- a. **Aircraft Launching and Landing** - No comments or questions.
- b. **Cemetery Ordinance** - Elin Elisofon presented a summary of the State Statute on cemeteries. It states there should be a 25' setback for cemeteries. The Cemetery Committee would like to have the ordinance published in the wind before it is voted on. There was discussion on creating a municipal code for violations, or making penalties the same for land use violations.
- c. **EMA** - No comments or questions
- d. **Quarry Preservation** - Jake asked if fires on the quarry while ice fishing were considered a pollutant. There was agreement that that should be covered with fire permits and regulations.

#### 2. Winter Maintenance Road Closures - Wes Reed said one of the providers may be buying a property on Bay View Cemetery Road so it may be beneficial to keep the winter maintenance.
