- APPROVE AND SIGN TREASURER'S WARRANTS #35 Motion by Eric Gasperini to approve and sign Treasurer's Warrant's #35. Second by Emily Lane. Vote 4-0-0. Motion carried.
- **APPROVE AGENDA** Motion by Emily Lane to approve the agenda as written. Second by Eric Gasperini. Vote 4-0-0. Motion carried.

## NEW BUSINESS

• **2016-2017 Budget Workshop** – Selectmen Budget was reviewed. Consensus of the Board to keep the budget the same as last year.

Legal Fees Budget was reviewed. There was an overview of past and current expenses including current land use cases, bond counsel, general council and the possibility of an appeal on a current Land Use Violation was discussed and having access to funds should be considered. Motion by Emily Lane to increase the Legal Fees budget to \$30,000. Second by Eric Gasperini. Vote 4-0-0. Motion carried.

Insurance Budget was reviewed. There was a consensus of the Board to go with Andy's recommendation of \$70,277.60 including the added Aviation Liability.

Social Security/Medicare Budget was reviewed. There was a consensus of the Board to go with Andy's recommendation of \$50,000.

General Assistance Budget was reviewed. State reimburses 50-70%. Number of GA recipients for previous years: 2011/2012 - 5; 2012/2013 - 8; 2013/2014 - 6; 2014/2015- 5. There was discussion on adopting a work fare program, Andy to look into sample programs. There was a consensus of the Board to go with Andy's recommendation of \$6,000.

Donations Budget was reviewed. There was a consensus of the Board to budget the

following donations totaling \$4,330.

Memorial Day - \$1,400

Penquis Cap - \$430

Lifeflight - \$1,000

Surplus Food - \$500

New Hope for Women - \$500

Penobscot East - \$500

CEO/LPI Budget was reviewed. There was a consensus of the Board to go with Andy's recommendation of \$23,157.

Assessor Budget was reviewed. Budget was set higher last year as the status of the position was unknown. Now the costs are split with the CEO/LPI position. There was a consensus of the Board to lower the travel & transportation budget to \$1,500 and to go with Andy's recommendation for the other line items for a total budget of \$18,959.05

Animal Control Budget was reviewed. There was a consensus of the Board to go with Andy's recommendation of \$5,700.

There was discussion on phone-in participation of meetings. Andy stated there is a bill going before legislature and asked if the board would like him to draft a letter in opposition. There was a consensus for Andy to draft a letter for the Board to review.
