

**TOWN OF VINALHAVEN
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT
November 10th, 2020**

To: Tanya Robishaw, Resident of Vinalhaven, in the County of Knox, State of Maine,

Greeting:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Vinalhaven in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at Ray's Field, at the intersection of Main Street and Atlantic Avenue, in said Town on November 10th, 2020, beginning at 4 pm, then and there to act upon Article 1 thru 2 as set out below, to wit:

Article 1. To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting and to fix compensation.

Article 2. To determine whether the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board to grant or deed easements over a certain Town property, the Booth's Quarry parcel, for access to an existing residence at 54 York Road, Map 26 Lot 09C for the benefit of current and future property owners of Map 26 Lot 09C.


This lot is currently served by an existing driveway accessible off the York Road and along an old private roadbed, referenced in Book 3479 Page 270 as Old Swamp Road, so-called. Access to this parcel and deeded access pre-date the town's acceptance of the adjacent Booth's Quarry lot which the "Old Swamp Road" travels across. The owner of Map 26 Lot 09C is in the processes of selling the said lot and the sale requires an easement be issued providing access along the existing driveway, or "Old Swamp Road", so-called.

Note: A copy of the drafted Municipal Quit Claim Deed along with other materials has been posted together with this warrant, and copies are available from the office of the town clerk and will be available at the town meeting.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours at Ray's Field from 4:00 p.m., on November 10th, 2020 until adjournment of the Special Town Meeting for the purpose of correcting the list of voters.




