Tick Talks

How to Properly Remove
a Tick:

1. Use fine tipped tweezers
2. Try to get the tweezers as close to the skin as you can 
3. Gently pull upward 
4. Keep gently pulling until the skin has tented and the tick releases itself
5. Place tick in a plastic bag or clear tape with the date on it
6. Wash the area of skin the tick was attached to with soap and water

2021-2022 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on Sept 1st, 2021. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1st, 2021. **If you sold your property after April 1st, 2021, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner.** Payments are due on November 1st, 2021, and **May 2nd, 2022.** Interest is accruing on unpaid November 1st payments. Dog Licenses - All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. **All dogs not licensed for 2022 will now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.**

No Clothing Donations July 14-July 18

This will be a "catch up" week – one to catch up with all the wonderful donations you have brought in.

Going to the mainland with an empty vehicle? Have a few minutes of extra time?

We need volunteers (who are already making a trip) to take our overflow to either Goodwill or the Salvation Army. It's not an easy process, but essential to ensuring that your donations that couldn't find a home here find one on the mainland. Here's how it works:

1. Notify Pat (pat.lundholm@gmail.com) or Heather (on Facebook, VH Swap Shop @ Town Garage) the day before you are going to make a trip.
2. We will confirm that they are accepting donations (they get overloaded, too).
3. If so, we will agree on a time to meet at the Swap Shop and load your vehicle.
4. If you have enough room to take 270 pounds, we will offer you a half ticket. This, sadly, is the break even for taking it to the dump instead.
5. Note: even small vehicles – Prius with seat down – take a lot! Even a small load (not enough for a ticket) is a big help.

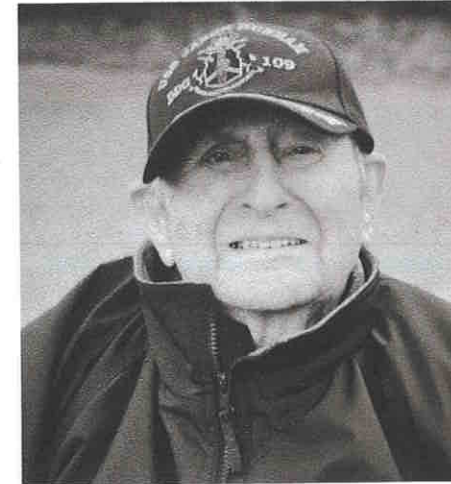

Carl H. Pinson Jr. Obituary

Carl H. Pinson Jr., formerly of Day's Ferry Woolwich and Vinalhaven Island, died Thursday, June 23, 2022, at HillHouse Assisted Living in Bath, ME.

He was born in Bath, April 24, 1932, a son of Carl H. and Elsie (Lake) Pinson Sr. Carl attended Brunswick schools and graduated from Brunswick High School with the class of 1950. He attended management classes at USM while working at Bath Iron Works until his retirement in 1990. Carl held positions from moulding loft to director of estimating. He was always the life of the party, the mayor of everywhere he lived.

He loved dancing with his soul mate, Lillias; his favorite music was from Nat King Cole, Josh Groban, and Johnny Mathis. He was an extraordinary boat builder, carpenter, gardener, and sailor. He was also a Mason of the Solar Star Lodge in Bath. He participated in many groups, combining his love of boating with his love of people, as harbormaster in Day's Ferry, a member of the Maine State Ferry Commission, Lions Club on Vinalhaven Island, and a proud member of the Bath Savings Board of Corporators. He was a member of the Day's Ferry Congregational Church and the United Congregational Church of Bath.

Carl has been called "a force of nature," "epic," "a legend," and, like his grandfather before him, "the Iron Man." But Carl, always humble, would say, "call me anything you want. Just don't call me late to dinner." He was a loving and devoted husband, father, uncle, and brother. He once told us, "You have to play the hand you're dealt." But he summed up by his childhood prayer: "God bless mommy, God bless daddy, God bless Peter and ...what's for breakfast?"

He was predeceased by his wife of 69 years, Lillias Julia Sullivan Pinson.

He is survived by two daughters, Julianne Dugas and her husband, Robert, of Yarmouth and Lisa Waite and her husband, Charles, of Portland; four grandchildren, Lynsey Waite, Jennifer Waite, Justin Dugas, and Tasha Dugas; and seven great-grandchildren, Alden, Trevor, Vivi, Bea, Theo, Grace, and Hazel.

A celebration of life was held at 10 a.m. Saturday, July 9, 2022, at Daigle Funeral Home, 819 High Street, Bath. Burial will be at Sea View Cemetery in Rockport at a later date.

The Vinalhaven Water District is requesting that customers in Vinalhaven connected to the public water system conserve water at this time. We are seeing a reduction in water storage due to recent water system leaks in addition to an increased demand on the system. We are currently working to locate and repair the leaks.
