Supper was served from a prettily decorated table with a centerpiece of rambler roses placed in a vase over 100 years old and an heirloom of Mrs. Smith's family. A 3-tiered checkerboard cake was beautifully decorated and made by Mrs. Louise Anderson. Courier-Gazette July 21, 1953

John Arey, Tim Lane, Mac Gilchrist, Bruce Arey, and Paul Hopkins pitched their tents and spent a night on the lawn of Mr. and Mrs. Leroy Arey's home on School St. July 29, 1947

Taxi fares have been raised, regretfully, to 35¢ minimum, other prices in proportion. Signed-All taxi operators on Vinalhaven. Courier-Gazette July 2, 1953 The boxing bear which appeared at North Haven in connection with the motion picture, afforded considerable interest to those present and also to Walter Joyce whom the bear sideswiped with his paw Thursday morning when being led to the boat by its keeper. The claws of the bear ripped Mr. Joyce's trousers and scratched his leg. The keeper and bear were taken to Rockland by Mr. Tabbutt in his motor boat.

The Strawberry Festival at the Union Church vestry was a success in everyway, a large number partaking of one of the finest suppers ever served there. Several distinguished guests were present, among them Carl E. Milliken, candidate for governor, and candidate for congress, Wallace H. White, Jr.

Miss Pauline V. Beal of Matinicus Rock discovered a peculiar cloud well up in the air in the inshore direction on the evening of July 3. Pauline keeps a sharp watch for thunder showers, but this time her cloud acted in a superstitious manner and finally she decided it was none other than the dirigible Shenandoah. She reported without delay and in the twinkling of an eye everyone was out with their glasses focused for their first glimpse of the giant navy dirigible. 

She met the love of her life, Martin in Boston and was a devoted wife and mother.



is for newspaper. The first newspaper on the island was The Wind, published in 1884, spearheaded by O.P. Lions and Charles Healey. In 1885, The Messenger printed 25 issues, with W.W. Freeman, James Grant, and Herbert Lovejoy as editors. In 1887, Charles Healey ran The Vinalhaven Echo for 14 months, followed by the shortlived The Vinalhaven Review, run by O. Dinsmore in 1895. The Islander, headed by Daniel Monro was in print for ten years, starting in 1900. For eighty-six weeks during 1938 and 1939, Sidney Winslow printed The Vinalhaven Neighbor. The lastest attempt to publish a local paper was by Rev. Raymond Blaisdell in 1974, and today that paper, The Wind, continues to be printed weekly.
