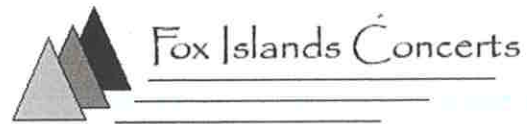

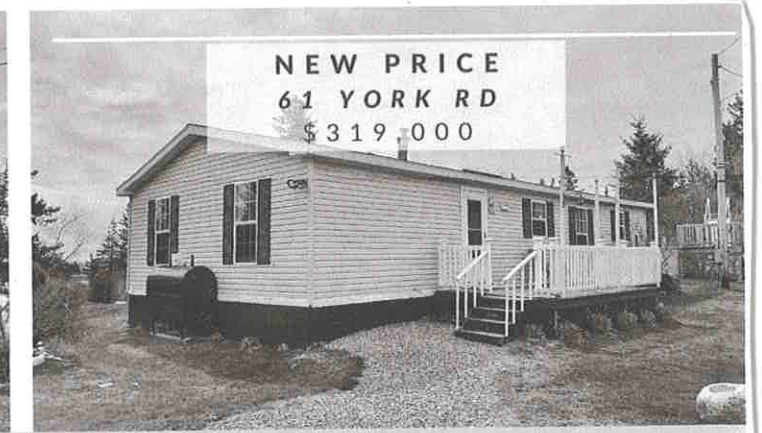

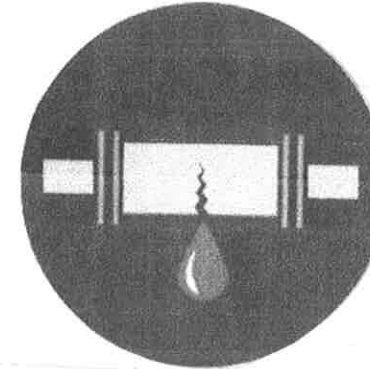

### Zucchini in Dill Cream Sauce

- 2 1/2 lb un-pared zucchini, cut into strips (7 C)
- 1/4 C finely chopped onion
- 1/2 C water
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp instant chicken bouillon granules
- 1/2 tsp dried dill weed
- 2 T butter
- 2 tsp sugar
- 1 tsp lemon juice
- 2 T flour
- 1/2 C sour cream

In saucepan, combine zucchini, onion, water, salt, bouillon granules, and dill weed, bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, covered, 5 min. or until zucchini is just tender. Do not drain. Add butter, sugar, and lemon juice. Remove from heat. Blend flour into sour cream. Stir about half the hot cooking liquid into the sour cream. Return all to saucepan. Cook and stir until thickened and bubbly. (6 servings)

**THE OBSERVER**  
 Many years ago, Jake, a gay friend for whom I'd been doing some remodeling vacationed in the Faroe Islands. He loved that country's flag, its colors & composition &, having purchased one at a gift shop, he hung it from a 40' flagpole in his front yard. During a regularly scheduled Selectmen's meeting the Board was considering Jake's appointment to the Park Commission. A Board member registered an oblique objection. When pressed, he blurted out, "Put him on the Park Commission, in charge of where kids hang out? Have you seen that flag?" "Flag?" I asked, puzzled. "That queer pride flag he's got flying right in our face," he stammered. Although he was corrected to understand that the correct term was Gay Pride, & informed of the flag's real origin, word only got out to those who paid attention. Among some, the fact that it a Faroe Islands Flag, not a Gay Pride Flag was apparently unpersuasive. A few days later, late at night, a few of them ran a rope from their truck to Jake's flagpole & pulled it over. Next morning, quite early, as an employee & I were headed to work, we found the pole lying in the road, obstructing our passage, & bent, about 10' from the base, nearly 90 degrees, that juncture where it had succumbed to the truck before being yanked out of the ground. Recognizing it for the vandalism that it was, we lashed it to my own truck, took it to my shop & tried to bend it back straight but the best we could do was create another bend a couple of feet from the first so that when we put it back in the ground, the pole went up 10', then horizontal a couple of feet or so, & then vertical again. When Jake woke up later that morning & looked out the window, the Faroe Islands Flag was flying, as always, but it was clearly a foot lower than it always had been & a few degrees farther to the westward. He called my house, quite concerned that my carpentry work had gone horribly wrong since his house was suddenly a foot higher than it had been when he went to bed and seemed to have shifted a little to the east. pc

**O** is for *Old Reuben*. In 1888 the island voted to purchase a steam fire engine to replace worn, outdated equipment. The result was the Silsby Manufacturing Company's fifth-size engine #912 which was named in honor of one of Vinalhaven's leading citizens, **Reuben Carver**, who made great contributions to the town in his 91 years. This model was made to be drawn by men with an optional conversion to become horse drawn. The men "not only like the little beauty for her power of perfect execution, but because the boys can haul her anywhere it is necessary for her to go." *Reuben's* vertical tube boiler was designed to produce steam quickly; full pressure was achieved in about twelve minutes. Time was saved by keeping a low fire going in the small coal stove at the engine house at all times. When the alarm was sounded, a shovelful of embers was thrown into *Reuben's* firebox, and she was on her way. *Old Reuben* served as Vinalhaven's primary engine until 1933.

# Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

The Vinalhaven Garden Club have announced that the Flower Show that was dated for August 1 has been postponed owing to dry weather and condition of flowers. July 29, 1952

The William Blaisdell, 35' motor boat, was named Minnie Ann, for the young daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George White. Minnie Ann was out sailing in the boat the next day after its arrival, and caught the first fish. Courier-Gazette July 12, 1949

Teddy Ames celebrated his 10th birthday Friday at the home of his grandparents Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Bennett. Present were Charlie and Charlene Polk, Johnny Bennett and Glennis Beckman. Games were played and lunch served. Teddy received several nice gifts. July 12, 1949

Last Saturday amid the storm and fog a wager of \$5 was made, among the guests at the Ocean House, that Mr. Frank Willard would not row around Lane's Island in a small Whitehall boat. He instantly accepted the wager and started from Capt. Lane's float. The fog was very dense and the sea was running high, but he gathered up his nerve and strength and stuck to it. When he reached the point at the mouth of Indian Creek, the roughest part of his journey, the boarders at the hotel gathered on the shore to encourage him through the breakers. The time occupied was 50 minutes. After landing the ladies pelted him with bouquets and the gentlemen took him on their shoulders, singing "For He's a Jolly Good Fellow." Mr. Willard is now a hero of the Ocean House.

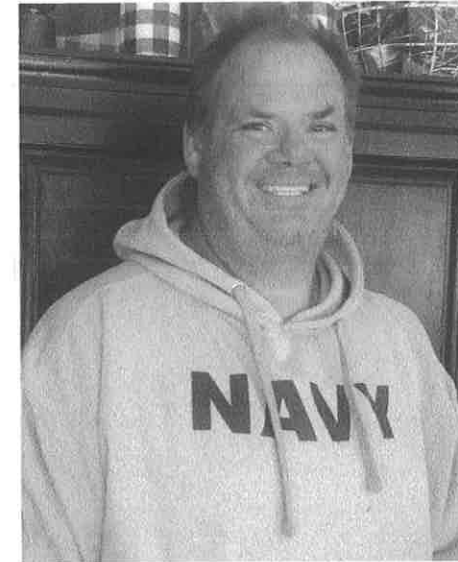

The Vinalhaven Band will board the 99-year-old packet *Joyce Rebecca* tonight, and a rather unusual open-air concert will be heard in mid-harbor. While repairing a gasoline pumping engine at the Hermann estate, Tuesday afternoon an explosion occurred from which Raymond Webster and Maynard Green were badly burned, Medical assistance was necessary. Courier-Gazette July 8, 1937

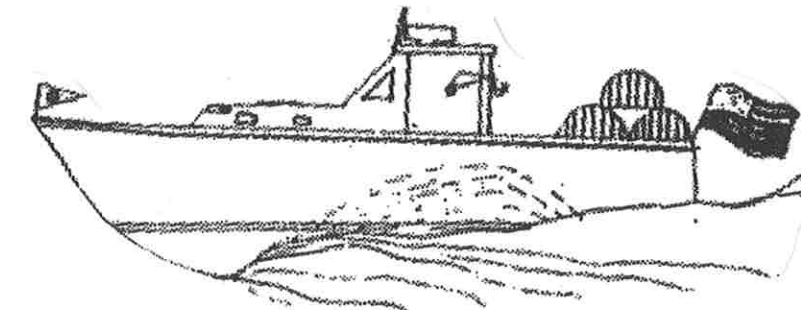
