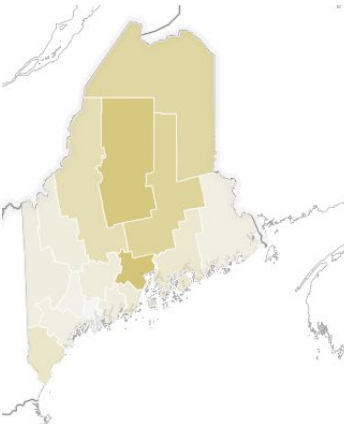

COVID-19 Community Update

As we head into the Labor Day weekend, here are some updates regarding COVID-19.

- In Maine, 665 new cases of COVID-19 were reported today. That is Maine's highest daily total since January when we were near the height of the pandemic.
- ICMS has shared that there have been two confirmed positive test results within the last 10 days. *(This does not include any results from tests conducted off-island)*
- More than 65.9 percent of all Maine residents (includes all ages) are fully vaccinated. Maine also continues to make progress in vaccinating younger people, with more than 54 percent of youth ages 12 to 19 being fully vaccinated.

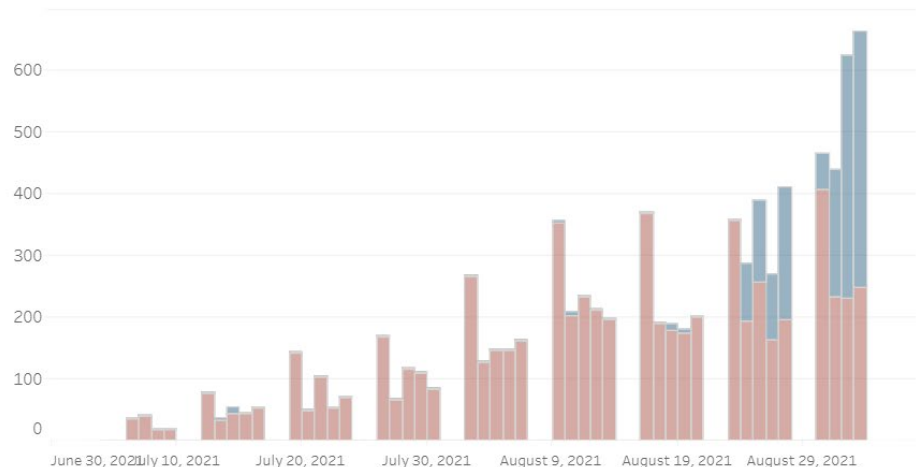
