**2022-2023 Property Taxes** – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. **Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023.** Interest will accrue November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. **2021-2022 Property Taxes** – Tax Liens will be filed this week at the Knox County Registry of Deeds for all 2021-2022 unpaid balances. Property owners with liens have 18 months to pay off the taxes or automatic foreclosure will occur as required by state law.

**Dog Licenses** – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.

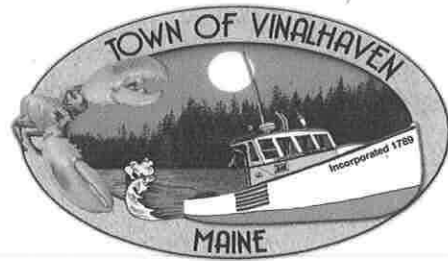

**BEGINNING TO WALK**

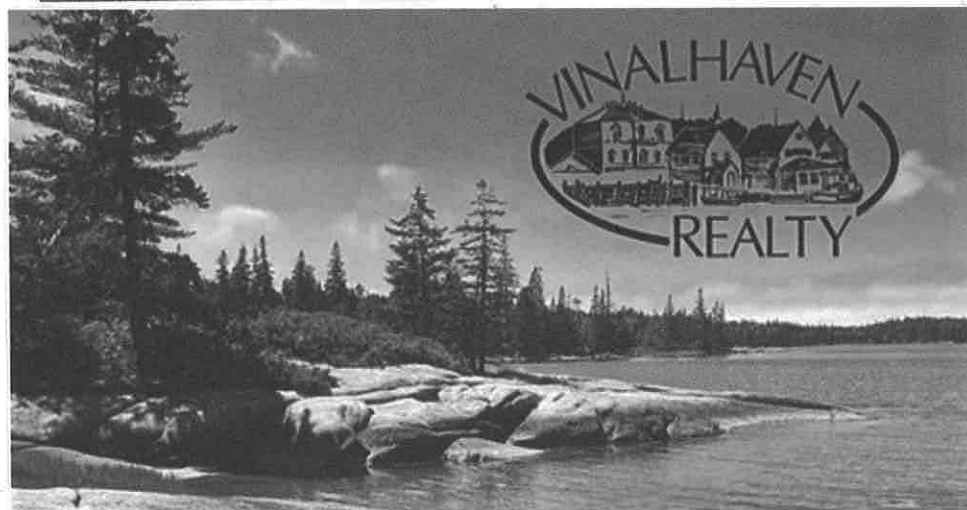

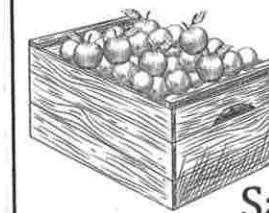

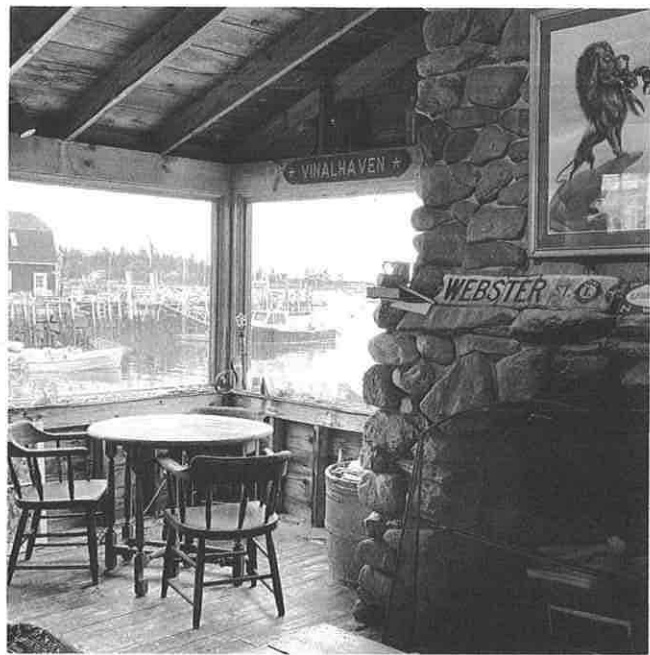

## Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

**A mystery then and a mystery still.** 15 minutes before 6 pm last Thursday, a tall, thin woman dressed entirely in black and closely veiled knocked at the door of one of the tenements in the Webster House occupied by James Brown. His 10 year old boy being the only one to answer the summons did so, and when the door was opened the woman walked in not saying a word, went up a flight of stairs into a bedroom and sat down on the bed. The boy being frightened said nothing. The woman came down, where the boy was trying to build a fire, asking who lived there and other questions. Then taking the kerosene can from the boy's hand poured a liberal amount of oil into the stove, and left as quietly as she came, never removing the veil while in the house. So her identity is a mystery. Mr. Brown says he wants it published, that she may know that he desires no more such mysterious visits to his house during his absence and to make known her wishes to him personally or some other method will be adopted to unearth this mystery.
