



2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

2021-2022 Property Taxes – Tax Liens will be filed this week at the Knox County Registry of Deeds for all 2021-2022 unpaid balances. Property owners with liens have 18 months to pay off the taxes or automatic foreclosure will occur as required by state law.

Dog Licenses – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.





Excerpt from an article in a Vinalhaven Neighbor...To us the house is ever a reminder of a famous game of cards played many years ago which resulted in grandfather's abhorrence of playing cards. It seems that he and a number of friends, among whom was Capt. Bill Lane, were engaged in a friendly game of cards when some sort of disagreement arose and loud words were spoken. While the discussion was at its height the house was suddenly shaken as if with a giant hand and the doors and windows rattled loud enough to drown the angry words. Extremely superstitious, all were silenced by, what seemed to them, occult reproof of their actions. At any rate grandfather was so impressed by the demonstration that he never played a game of cards thereafter...

The Social Committee with Doris Arey, chairman, assisted by Cora Peterson and Gladys Coombs held a most successful Halloween party Wednesday evening. The vestry showed the Halloween season with decorations of orange and black streamers, witches and black cats and wise old owls. The darkened entrance was well guarded by ghosts and goblins, shaking a friendly by gruesome hand. Various games and contests were played. Refreshments of doughnuts, cider and candies were served, after which the ghosts and witches Oct. 31, 1953 retired for another year.






