



2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

**2021-2022 Property Taxes** – Tax Liens will be filed this week at the Knox County Registry of Deeds for all 2021-2022 unpaid balances. Property owners with liens have 18 months to pay off the taxes or automatic foreclosure will occur as required by state law.

Dog Licenses – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$1 I for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.



# Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

Friends of Mr. and Mrs. M.P. Smith celebrated Mrs. Smith's birthday Saturday evening at the Red Lion. Nearly 30 guests were present and enjoyed an excellent supper which included two large birthday cakes. Dancing and cards were features of the evening. The hostess was the recipient of a handsome toilet seat.

Oct 3. 1922

In connection with other granite jobs being done by B.G.Co., they have the contract for building the library and musical con-servatory for Alleghany City, PA. This is a large job and will require a year or more to complete it. The building is a gift of the iron king Andrew Carnegie to Alleghany City. It is to be of red and gray granite, a few lower courses of red and the remaining structure of the Sands gray granite, and several fronts will show most entirely rock face. Its odd and unique design make it an elegant looking building. VH Echo Oct. 7, 1887

The Astronomy Class, Miss Nellie Hall, teacher, will meet Thursday at 7:30 in the Community Hall. Oct. 6, 1942

Oct. 7, 1952

William Arey, who lives alone at the point near the Reach, now known as Shore Acres, was rudely disturbed from his rest Monday night. Believing a sound to be the wind rattling the door, he arose from his bed and went below where he was met by a masked man who covered him with a revolver, and entered the house demanding money, Mr. Arey gave him what he had and the burglar left with \$8 as a reward for his bold attack.




Oct 6, 1960

# Vinalhaven School NEWS!

It's here? Yes! If you want to see our new fully electric bus in color, with bright yellow and blue, check out the Vinalhaven School Facebook page. We will use Facebook to update parents and students as we move closer to delivering kids to and from school. Once we have the bus in motion, you'll notice that it is very quiet, is fume free for travelers, and has an excellent system for accommodating wheel chair use.

When? The new bus requires some specific set-up from the company, installation of the camera system, mandated training for our new drivers, and other prep to make sure our first trips with students are safe and well organized. Our goal is to have the bus running as soon as we meet all local, state, and federal requirements. When we are closer to running routes, we will inform parents, have kids practice safe loading/unloading and expected behavior, and make sure all parents know about pick-up times and sign up. We'll provide a "what you need to know about riding the bus" meeting for parents. We want kids to feel confident about their first ride.

**Info**: After receiving \$100,040 in grant funding, the remaining cost of the bus is \$239,000. This type of electric bus is made of a composite so that it will not rust out (as with our last bus). It is designed to operate in both hot and very cold weather. The expected savings in energy cost compared to traditional buses is 80%, with a 60% reduction in maintenance cost. We will continue to monitor other grant options with the hope of reducing our total cost for the new bus.

Classroom Support? Throughout the year, Vinalhaven School will always accept applications for Ed Tech positions. Sometimes new students enroll during the year, and may require extra help in the classroom or with individual work. An Ed Tech works with a classroom teacher to help meet those academic needs.
