**APRIL 25 NATIONAL ZUCCHINI BREAD DAY**

**Zucchini Bread**

- 3 eggs
  - 1 ¼ to 2 ½ C sugar
  - 1 C vegetable oil
  - 2 C grated zucchini
  - 2 tsp cinnamon
  - 1 tsp salt
  - 1 tsp baking soda
  - ¼ tsp baking powder
  - 3 C unsifted flour
  - 1 C chopped walnuts
- Beat eggs until foamy. Gradually beat in oil and sugar. Add grated zucchini, cinn., salt, b. soda & b. powder. Gradually blend in flour, mix well. Fold in walnuts. Pour into a greased & floured 3qt. Bundt pan or 2 loaf pans. Bake at 350° for approx. 1 hr. or until cake tests done. Cool in pan 10 min. and turn out on rack. Great with cream cheese.

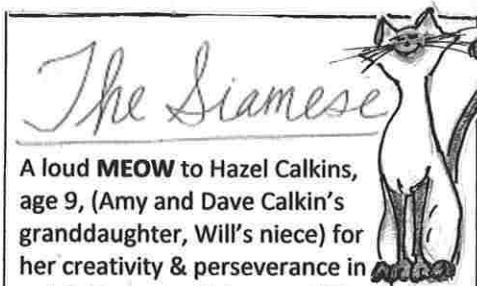

**2021-2022 Property Taxes** – Tax bills were mailed out on Sept 1st, 2021. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1st, 2021. **If you sold your property after April 1st, 2021, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner.** Payments are due on November 1st, 2021, and May 2nd, 2022. Interest is accruing on unpaid November 1st payments. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 for an interest figure.

**Dog Licenses** - All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. **All dogs not licensed for 2022 will now have the \$25 late fee per dog.**

### HARBOR MASTER NOTICE

There are two boat trailers parked at the Harbor Wharf in the auto parking permit area. This area along the road is for autos that have a long-term permit only. If you are parking your vehicle in this area, you must have a long-term permit issued from the Town Office.

Boat Trailers have a 48-hour limit only and must be removed. There are no license plates on these two trailers. If you read this notice and know the owners, please inform them as they must be removed, or the Town will remove them and there will be costs to the owners.

Trucks and autos must be parked at least 40 feet from the wharf edge so fishermen can have room to work. Stop using the wharf as your personal dump for junk and garbage. Please remove your drags and pick up after yourself.

Luncheon was served.

Courier-Gazette April 30, 1936

"**The Frog Holler Country Club**" met Thursday night at the Darres camp for supper and a social evening. Those present were: Horatio Torfason, Gerald Lloyd, Colon Winslow, Walter Smith, Homer Darres, Clinton Smith, Carl Williams and Gleason McHenan.

Courier-Gazette April 23, 1935

**I. W. Komisky of Boston**, The New England States representative of the I. C. Smith & Co., has been the guest this past week of Mr. and Mr. F. M. White. Saturday the following party enjoyed a lobster feed at Craventhurst; H. W. Fifield, F. F. Brown, F. F. Ames, C. G. Chilles, A. U. Patterson, L. W. Sanborn, T. E. Libby, F. M. White, C. S. Roberts, Frederick Jones, I. W. Komisky, W. F. Lyford and L. C. Smith. Edward McDonald, Sr., was chef. Mr. Komisky gave a talk on Albalpol and Magic Window cloth as a new and booming industry to the town. He is introducing these through Payne & Dunham of Boston.

Courier-Gazette April 21, 1925

**In Shipping News:** Sch. *Metropolis* loaded rough stone for Boston. Sch. *Abbie S. Walker* loaded curbing for Philadelphia. Sch. *Ohio* loaded paving for Portland, to be shipped hence to St. Louis. Sch. *J. R. Bodwell* is loading stone for the State, War and Navy building Washington, D. C. The schooner *J. B. Holden* of Rockland, the largest and finest vessel ever at the Sands Wharf, will load 56,000 paving blocks for New York.

Vinalhaven Messenger late 1880's

**Mrs. Morgan Sutcliffe** is conducting a nursery school three mornings a week at her home on West Main Street, which is proving to be popular with the children attending.

Courier-Gazette April 1, 1950

**Ralph Candage and Gerald Webb** are razing the old coal shed on the Steamboat Wharf. The lumber will be utilized in the construction of Mr. Candage's barn and a store building for Mr. Webb.

Vinalhaven Neighbor April 26, 1939

**Headquarters European Theater of Operations:** It is announced that Sergeant Clinton K. Smith, son of Mr. & Mrs. Benjamin K. Smith, of Vinalhaven, stationed at a Fighter Base in England, has recently been promoted from the grade of corporal. Sgt. Smith, prior to his induction into the Armed Forces at Portland was employed as a shipfitter at the Bath Iron Works. After his basic training at Miami Beach, Fla., Sgt. Smith attended an Armament school at Buckley Field, Denver, Co., and was assigned to his present organization as an Armorer in Sept. 1943.

Courier Gazette April 7, 1944

**Betty Lou Hanley**, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Seth Hanley of Rockland celebrated her 4th birthday Friday afternoon at the home of her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Robertson. Games were enjoyed. Lillian Philbrook and Billy Holmquist winning the prizes in the jelly bean hunt. Sandwiches, cookies and four birthday cakes were served. Candy filled baskets and balloons were used as favors, Betty Lou received many lovely gifts. Guests were Janice and Billy Wadleigh, Shirley and Ronnie Davis, Donald and Dorothea Woodcock, Mrs. Olaf Holmquist and son Billy, Larry and "Barty" Hopkins, Lillian Philbrook, Patricia and Alice Dodge, Perry Parmenter, Ira Machan of Boothbay Harbor, Carl Philbrook, Laretta Shields, Mary Chandler, Linda Hanley of Rockland and Edwina Hackett of Milo.

Courier-Gazette April 28, 1944

**Gilbert Warren**, son of Mr. and Mrs. Risty Warren celebrated his 4th birthday Saturday from 2 to 4 o'clock. Those present were: Gwendolyn Robertson, Phyllis Bogren, Jane Shields, Phyllis Robertson, Mary Warren and Richard Warren. Ice Cream, cake and cookies were served.

Courier-Gazette April 23, 1936

**Walter Mills** has started a turkey farm and at present has 300 birds.

Courier-Gazette April 28, 1944

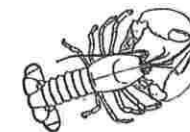

**A** is for Alumni Association. Alumni records indicate that the Vinalhaven Alumni Assoc. was started in Oct. 1919, by Chester Soule, who was the school principal here at the time. The first meeting was held in Jennie Patterson's house (14 High St.) with six in attendance. The following year the meeting was held in the Union Church vestry; a turkey dinner was served and Dr. Langtry Crockett, class of 1888 (Vinalhaven's first graduating class) was the guest speaker. For 52 years the banquet was held in the vestry, but because of increased membership was moved to the gymnasium in 1969, and to the new Vinalhaven school in 2004. By 2010, interest had waned and the Vinalhaven Alumni Association was dissolved.

## Joe's Movie Reviews

### Spider-man All the Way to Bank

"Spider-man No Way Home" is the latest addition to the Marvel cinematic universe. The movie, starring Tom Holland and Zendaya, and directed by Jon Watts, was released on December 17th and is still playing in theaters. It also has already made \$1.867 billion dollars at the box office, making it the sixth top-grossing movie of all time. "No Way Home" is one of the best movies that Marvel has produced, and a great gift to Spider-man fans around the world.

The character of Spider-man has been the subject of many movies over the years, including two reboots. This movie gives a satisfying resolution to all of them, and still sets up the future of that franchise. Characters from all three different franchises --Toby Maguire's Spectacular Spider-man, Andrew Garfield's Amazing Spider-man, and Tom Holland's MCU Spider-man-- are brought together in this movie and it works perfectly. The dialogue between the characters is wonderful and funny, there were many rewarding and emotional moments, like Andrew Garfield's Spider-man having a redeeming moment.

Another thing I liked about it was Tom Holland's Spider-man character arc. I thought it really completed his journey from Tom Holland's first movie as a high school crime fighter, to now becoming an adult and making a huge selfless decision at the end of the movie.

My only major grief with the movie is the way they brought all the characters together. I thought it didn't make much sense, even for a superhero movie.
