An open letter to our community....

from the ICMS Board of Trustees

If someone leaves a position at the grocery or at the bar or the gas station, it hardly causes a ripple. No one is constricted from speaking so there is usually no mystery and few secrets, particularly in a small town. Employees, supervisors, even employers, come and go; it's normal.

That which appears to some to be chaos and turmoil at our Medical Center is the same thing, but in a closely regulated environment in which confidentiality is mandated.

The ICMS is an independent, Federally Qualified Health Center 501(c)(3), a private non-profit organization. Its pledge, embedded in its bylaws, is to dedicate itself to making every effort to support and provide access to quality 'whole health' care to everyone, all of us.

Toward that end and with that pledge in mind, we ask you trust and support our efforts and those of the individuals and consultants who are helping us make a necessary transition go smoothly.

Please, also, help us welcome Cameron (Cam) Garrett, our new Executive Director, who'll be joining us on June 7th.







Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

The fishing business on Matinicus is flourishing this season. An A new business recently started on Main Street is "The Kiddies idea of how the business is done may be of some interest to many of the Echo readers. Most of the fishing is done in small and open boats which range from 15 to 35' in length. The present season has been a prolific one for the fishermen as fish are plenty and bring better prices than the previous year. Fish are brought from the boats before being dressed, but those brought from vessels are dressed and salted. To give an idea to what extent the little island is engaged in the fish business-the recent landing of forty small boats in one day was about 47,800 round fish, employing 15 hands in dressing and salting them. There are about 300 hogsheads of fish on hand now. The fish trap has been catching 100 bushels daily. The management of the trap are feeling quite encouraged that they will do fairly well this season. although the herring are rather late in coming. Recently the fish trap contained a shark 9'.

The baby is a darling lamb and anyone would love it...Incidentally, if no one has guessed this, 'Susie Bray' is a sheep and the baby is her little lamb. C-G Mar.3, 1928
