### Did You Know?

To "josh" means to joke or make fun of, usually at someone else's expense. Josh Billings was one of America's most celebrated humorists. He lived from 1818 to 1885. His writings were sharp, humorous and witty...and he frequently mocked the goings-on of public officials, high society, and "big wigs" in general. He was the first American humorist to become a best-selling author, and his name was known in every household. So widely read was Billings that it became the practice to say, "to josh" instead of "to joke."

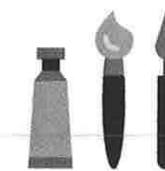
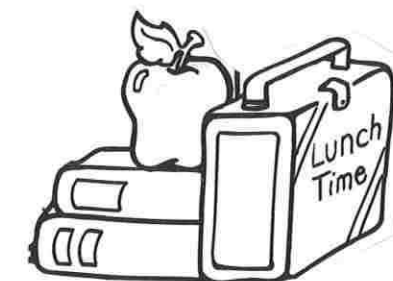

*Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society*

**At a meeting of the stockholders** of the Vinalhaven Net Factory Building Co., it was voted to build an addition to the present factory to accommodate the increased business of the L. C. Chase Co. The addition will be 38x60', 3 story in height. Everett Spear & Co., of Rockland, who has the contract, will commence work on the building within two months. The work to be completed early in August. The addition when completed will cost approx. \$4500. The money for the building was raised in a few days, by the sale of stock, there being 90 shares at \$50 each, showing that when the people of Vinalhaven see a good investment, there is plenty of money to finance it.  
**May, 1916**

**A new bank building** of fire-proof and burglar-proof construction is to be erected at once for the Security Trust Co. at Vinalhaven. The W. H. Glover Co. of Rockland has the contract and will begin work at once, with a view to having the structure ready for occupancy early the coming year. The new building will be constructed of brick with cast-stone trimmings, and its dimensions will be 30x40'. A large modern vault will provide ample room for safe deposit boxes. The equipment of the building will include modern heating apparatus and electric protection against burglar assaults. The estimated cost of the building inclusive of fixtures is about \$30,000.  
**October 6, 1928**

Workmen broke ground for the new bank building which is to be erected on Main Street between the Merrithew Studio and what was formerly the Winslow Studio. W. H. Glover, Co. of Rockland has the contract and E. L. Glidden of this town is superintendent.  
**October 13, 1928**

**A Model Theatre.** C. A. Shields, proprietor of the Rink Hall, has had it fitted up with all the conveniences and contrivances necessary for all purposes. The stage has been enlarged to a capacity of 16x40' with crimson curtains of 100 yds. Covering the wings, and so arranged that when a section of the sliding stage is removed it will follow the stage back to its original size and thus enlarge the floor room when necessary. A fine new drop curtain is now under the artist's brush, and will add new attractions to the state. The hall is furnished with lights, one of which has a capacity of 15 ordinary hall lamps, making it light and pleasant for an audience. In addition to all this is a fine piano just purchased for the hall. So any one hiring the hall for any show purpose will find everything as convenient as in any show house in Knox County. The walls of the house are soon to be kalsomined, making it still more attractive. Mr. Shields intends to add new attractions as occasion demands, and as Vinalhaven is one of the best show towns in Knox County so it has one of the finest halls for the purpose.  
**Vinalhaven Echo June 7, 1888**

**One of our prominent businessmen** on Main Street while digging clams recently found buried deep in the mud a Waltham watch. 18 size and 17 jewels, movement number 17087194, 20 year gold filled case number 6727517.  
**October 1919**

**The Schooner Ohio**, owned by the B. G. Co., and recently wrecked on Nash Island, has been sold for \$125. She was commanded by Capt. Fred Smith of this place. All hands saved.

## Letters from Fafa

My family spent every summer with my grandparents on the shores of Lake Michigan. We called my grandfather "Fafa" and my grandmother "Gama." Fafa (Harry Stiles) was an amateur naturalist. During the off seasons from 1952 (when we were 5 and 7) to 1955, Fafa would write letters to entertain us and maintain our interest in nature. I recently found copies of those letters in an old box of papers. Here is the fourth one in the series. Enjoy! —David Wylie

### The Hummingbird's Nest

October 13, 1952

Dear children,

Did Gama tell you we found a hummingbird's nest? Well, we did. One day in late summer we were walking in the woods when I noticed a hummingbird hovering overhead. I thought it was funny he should be there when suddenly he darted to his nest. The female was on the nest, but why, I don't know, for it was long after their regular nesting season. That is the way we found it.

We waited a week until we knew the birds had left for the south to spend the winter. Then I took the long-poled tree trimmer and we started for the nest. But as long as the trimmer pole was, about 20 feet, and my standing on my tip-toes, I was still five or six feet from reaching it. Now what do you suppose we did? Gama drove the station wagon right under the tree, I climbed to the top, and that way we could just reach the little branch the nest was on. I clipped it off and down it came. You know, of course, that birds in general do not use a nest again but build one the next year. However the eagles and ospreys do use the same nest year after year, rebuilding and adding to the old one.

We wanted the hummingbird's nest so we could show it to you next summer. It is a marvelous thing. An exquisite cup not over two inches across and built up of little pieces of fern, grass, and lined with down, most likely dandelion down, and then all bound together with spider webs. To finish, the birds collect small lichens and cover the outside so cleverly that even when you see the nest you think it is just a knot on the limb. They generally build pretty high from the ground and always on a horizontal branch. This nest was about thirty feet up.

You know, of course, that in the eastern United States we only have the ruby-throated hummingbird, but in the far west, they have about a dozen varieties.

Do you remember the one we found that had stunned itself by flying into the window? Remember how little he weighed when you held him and I told you he weighed not much more than a copper penny, and you held it in one hand and a penny in the other to prove it? Remember the beauty of his coloring - the metallic greens and bronzes which were always changing colors as the sunlight hit at different angles? And that beautiful ruby colored throat. Many birds each year kill themselves by flying into the glass. Perhaps they see their reflections and thinking it is another bird encroaching on their territory, attempt to fight it off. But also remember how I showed you how this bird was still alive, and by letting it rest in the sun it finally came alive. He wasn't very frisky at first, for he had an awful knock on his noggin. That gave us the chance to examine him closely, and always the colors are more vivid on a live bird. That was a wonderful experience few children ever have.

Did you ever watch a hummingbird fly? His wings go so fast you can't see them beat, and he is the only bird that can hover, fly backwards, and sidewise. The nearest to him in flying ability is the sphinx moth, and these two are sometimes confused for they do look alike. Some day I will write you a letter about the sphinx moth.

Also next summer remember to have me show you how the hummingbird likes to play in the spray from a hose. He just loves a fine spray and play for minutes in it. And if you remain quiet and gradually shorten the spray, you can get him up to within a foot of you. I have found that he is not so afraid of a person than he is of the person's voice. I can have him up close to my hands and he doesn't seem to mind even movement but let me try to call Gama to come see it, and at the first sound of my voice away he goes.

As little as the hummingbird is, don't think the other birds don't respect him. He will go at a hawk quickly as if the hawk was his own size. Of course, he would have no reason to do so unless he thought his nest was in danger. And the needle-like bill he has must make other birds think he has just run into a thistle! Anyway, they make room for the hummingbird and leave him and his family alone.

Lastly, can you imagine a little bird like this with wings that beat so fast starting out over the water for a 500 mile trip? Yet that is just what he does every fall when he leaves the United States for Central or South America for the winter. Then of course in the spring he has to return. I bet that even if you had wings you would rather try to swim it.

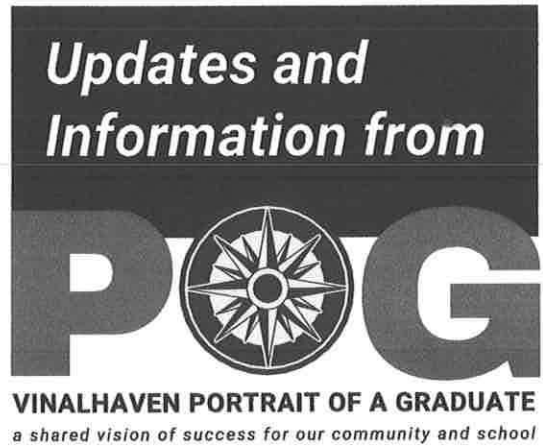
