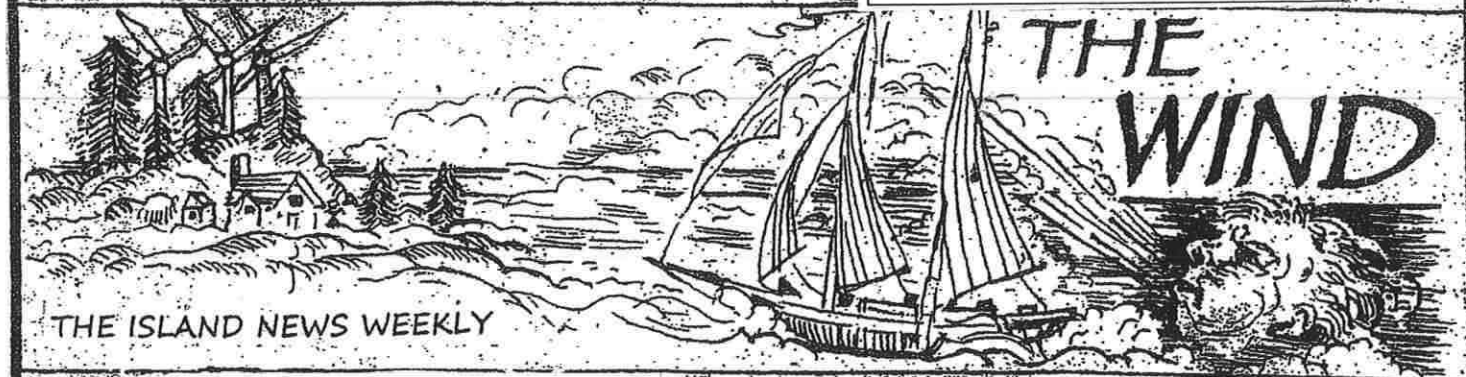

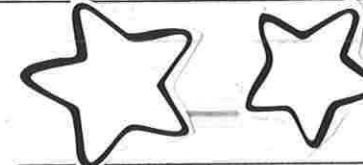

Vinalhaven M.S.F.S. Standby Line Policy

The standby line, located along the guardrail on the road opens at 6:00 a.m. WORLD CLOCK TIME. Vehicles are not allowed to line up anywhere in the standby line until 6:00 a.m. sharp.

Passengers must be inside their vehicles, with tickets 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. Anyone not in their vehicles 30 minutes prior to sailing time will be directed to the end of the line.

Vehicles are not to extend beyond the guardrail. Vehicles beyond the appointed standby line (the length of the guardrail) are not considered.

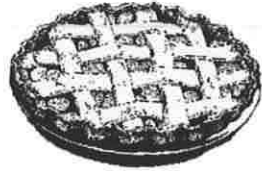
If you do not get on the ferry you may leave your vehicle as long as you intend to travel on the next departing ferry and are in your vehicle 30 minutes prior to the next scheduled departure time.

Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

The 4th of July Celebration! An all-night cabaret at the Net
Factory the night before, two-hour programs interspersed with the
dances, music by the Fakers. Lunches served day and night.
Parade at 9 a.m. Ball games at 10.30 and 2.30 between two local
teams. Dancing will be continued on the night of the Fourth at the
factory, where a Chevrolet car will be awarded during the dance.

July 2, 1931

Saturday, July 10, 1920. A Centennial Fair is being held today at
Wharff's Quarry. An entertainment will be given by local girls
and lunches served on the grounds. Autos will run to Granite
Island and motor boat to Wharff's Quarry. This is an Armenian
benefit.

Mr. & Mrs. Edward Ames were given a surprise shower party
Saturday night at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Lloyd. The
newly married couple received many beautiful gifts. Lunch was
served, about 30 guests being present. Three reels of moving
pictures of big fishing vessels were shown by Wilfred Nickerson.

Courier-Gazette July 8, 1937

The new fire company was out for practice last week. In just seven
minutes they had a stream of water on four different houses.

Courier-Gazette Dec. 9, 1890

Alfred Greenlaw, 14-year-old son of Mr. & Mrs. Jesse Greenlaw
and a pupil in the Lincoln school, experienced a miraculous
escape from instant death Tuesday evening while skiing on
Beggs' Hill in the Thomas field. Before taking a high jum, one of
his skis caught and turned nearly perpendicular. The boy's body
dropped upon it, and the point of the splintered ski penetrated his
throat and through into his mouth, removing one tooth and
loosening another. The boy, after several attempts, pulled out the
large piece of broken ski and walked home. Medical attendance
was immediately given by Dr. Shields and several stitches taken
to close the wound. Alfred showed wonderful courage through it
all.

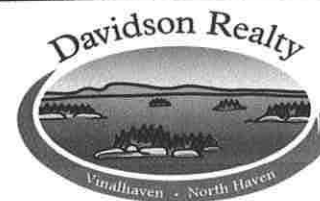

Invasive Plant Walk

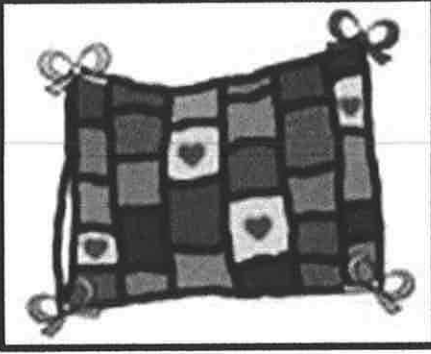

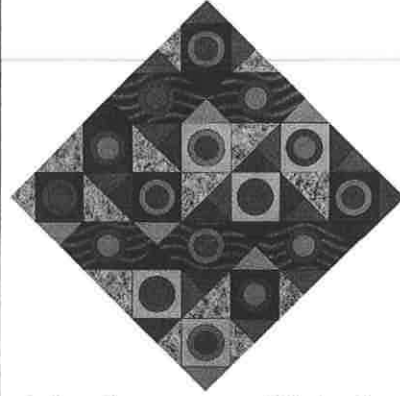

Asking For Help

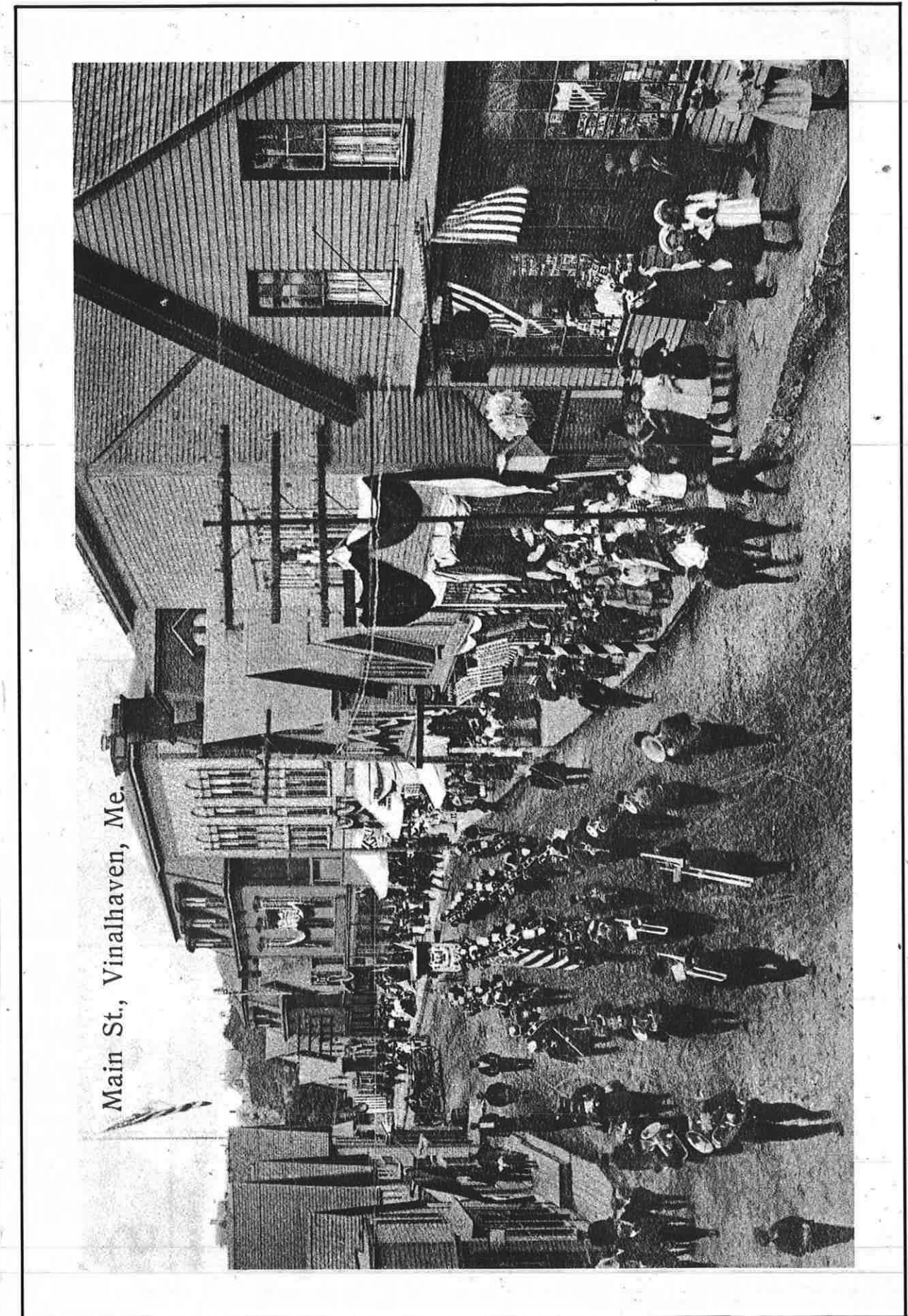
