2021-2022 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on Sept 1st, 2021. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1st, 2021. If you sold your property after April 1st, 2021, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments were due on November 1st, 2021, and May 2nd, 2022. Interest is accruing on unpaid payments. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 for an interest figure.

Dog Licenses – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.

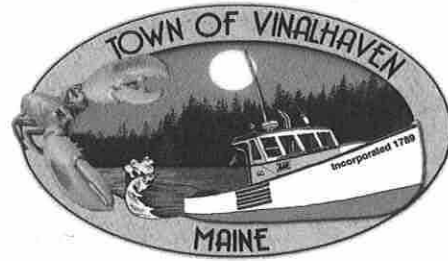

Tis for Trotting Park. The Trotting Park was the creation of several young men on the island. Even though they worked nine or ten hour days cutting granite, fishing, and other employment, they found time to build a trotting park on the North Haven Road across from F.S. Walls Watering Trough. The track was 30 feet wide and a half mile around. Entries for races at The Trotting Park came from Belfast, Rockport, Hope, Lincoln, Camden, Rockland, Bangor, and Vinalhaven. There was great enthusiasm for harness racing from 1884 to 1909. The purses ranged from \$50 to \$185, and a fare from the mainland, including admission to the park was 75¢. The last race in Vinalhaven was in 1909, with J.S. Black presiding as judge. In the winter, the same men raced with sleighs on Carver's Pond and Old Harbor Pond. Occasionally, men and women raced their sleighs on Main Street. Many of the first sleighs were manufactured at the State Prison in Thomaston.

We used to buy eggs and milk, homemade butter and produce from Sidney Mills, who owned the Mills Farm out on Mill River. Sidney came into town every few days in his horse and wagon and went door to door selling his product to folks who had a standing order and to others as well. Sidney's wife was Flossie, a sister to Susie Woodcock and to Beth Whitmore and to Roy Dyer's Mom, Mihaly. In the winter Sidney traveled the same route but with a horse and sleigh. The horse or maybe the sleigh wore bells, and I could hear them coming from a long way. One sad day, Sidney was struck by lightning out on the farm and died. He and Flossie had no kids. Later, Hollis Burgess owned the farm. His father was a brother to my grandfather. Im

**National Suicide Prevention Week
September 4 - 10**

A campaign observed in the U.S. to educate & inform about prevention and warning signs, to reduce the stigma surrounding and encouraging health assistance.

On August 17, 1894, the United States Congress passed the latest of many iterations of the River and Harbor Act, which was first enacted in the early part of that century. The Act was generally intended to ensure safe passage, riparian rights and defense of the nation's many navigable salt and fresh waterways. On February 9 of 1895 the Secretary of War, under whose auspices the Act was administered, submitted to congress a plan for constructing a breakwater from Lanes Island to Green Ledge, a distance of more than a quarter mile, to protect Carver's Harbor from southern storm surges and from accumulating sediment. At the time Carver's Harbor was a valued and busy commercial hub, shipping prized granite all over the country. That wall was never built but it's interesting to note it was once contemplated as, today, the island addresses the likelihood of sea levels continuing to rise and eventually threaten the community and downtown area. A gated breakwater from Potato Island or perhaps Bar Island or Lanes Island, across the mouth of the Harbor to Smith Point, a wall of sufficient height to protect the area from the twice daily tides that will, during the next century, comprise that threat, is among the proposals that the Town's Downtown Revitalization and Sea Level Rise Committees might want to consider as we consider our options. pc

Middle and high school students are dropped off and wait near the middle school doors.

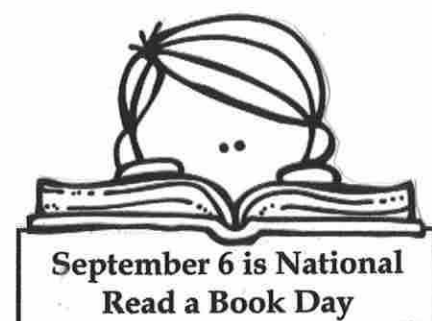

A special schedule has been arranged for Vinalhaven for Labor Day. Steamer leaves Vinalhaven for Rockland at 5 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Leaves Rockland for Vinalhaven at 7 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. The 7 a.m. and 1 p.m. trips from Vinalhaven and 9.30 and 3.20 trips from Rockland will be cancelled for the day.

Sept. 4, 1920

The Vinalhaven Regatta Club will have a clam bake this week.

Sept. 13, 1887

The Sanborn Bungalow, which was located on the height overlooking Roberts Harbor and the bay, is being rebuilt at Indian Creek, not far from Bohonkus the B. K. Smith bungalow.

Sept. 2, 1920

Lucy Bickford, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Maurice Bickford, celebrated her 9th birthday Saturday with a party at the home of her parents. The afternoon was gaily passed with various games. First Prized in the donkey game was won by Peter Palazzola, second by Anne Bickford. Three beautifully decorated birthday cakes, made by Mrs. Bickford, and ice cream were served, the table being attractively decorated with yellow and white flowers. Lucy received many especially fine gifts. Those present were Laverne, Valerie & Clyde Orcutt, Anne & Jean Bickford, Elaine, Gloria & Lowell Hildings, Sharon Healey, Barbara Webb, Patsy Smith, Nancy Adams, Stephen Kallock, Susan Webster, Rosemary Anthony, Larry Hopkins, Mary Catherine Bickford. Special guests were Hildred & Beatrice Hildings and Lucy's grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. John Hildings.

Sept. 7, 1950
