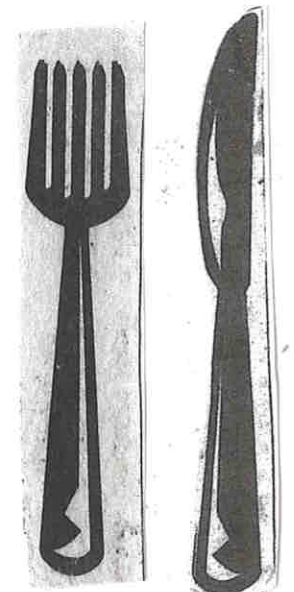

2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

2021-2022 Property Taxes – Tax Liens will be filed this week at the Knox County Registry of Deeds for all 2021-2022 unpaid balances. Property owners with liens have 18 months to pay off the taxes or automatic foreclosure will occur as required by state law.

Dog Licenses – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.

Single-Stream Recycling – # 1-7 rigid plastics, tin, aluminum, glass, paper, cardboard.

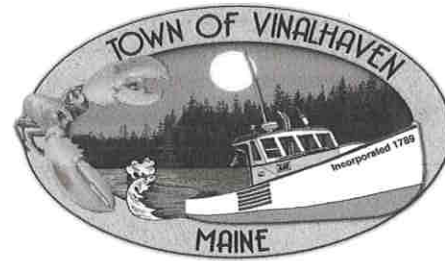

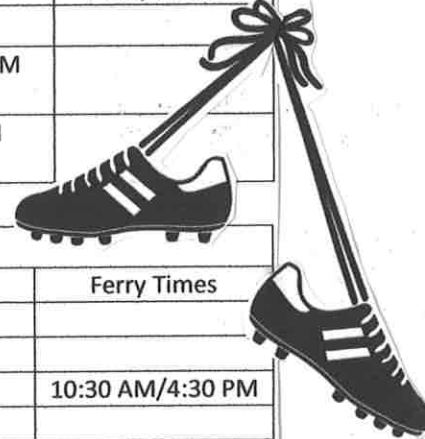

Early Notice and Public Review of a Proposed Activity in a Floodplain – Vinalhaven, Maine

To: All interested Agencies, Groups, and Individuals

The Northern Border Regional Commission (NBRC) intends to fund the following Proposed Action under the State Economic & Infrastructure Development Investment (SEID) Program. NBRC will prepare an 8-Step Decision-Making Process review in compliance with Executive Order (EO) 11988 (Floodplain Management) as amended by Executive Order 13690 (Establishing a Federal Flood Risk Management Standard and a Process for Further Soliciting and Considering Stakeholder Input).

The purpose of the Proposed Action is to renovate the Vinalhaven Downtown area, which serves commercial fishing and supports the Town's tourist activities, which are the two principal employment sectors on the island. The project will remedy deficiencies in parking lots and boat launches and mitigate flooding impacts to structures and public infrastructure. This is aligned with the SEID Program's Transportation Infrastructure, Basic Public Infrastructure, and Resource Conservation, Tourism, Recreation priorities.

Components of the Proposed Action includes:

1. Upgrading the Downtown Parking Lot and Improving the Boat Launch, which involves reconstructing the downtown parking lot located on Main Street, Vinalhaven across from Carvers Harbor Market (44.047308, -68.833475), improving the commercial and recreational boat launch, and repairing/replacing the bulkheads, which are located at the downtown parking lot. The purpose of the improvements to this site are to reduce flooding and support economic activity.
2. Preparing Net Factory Site for Eventual Repurposing, which involves relocating the current Vinalhaven Water District Offices to the existing wastewater treatment facility property located at 62 Sands Road (44.044985, -68.840564). The purpose of this action is to accommodate short-term offices for construction employees to support the project and to enable the site to eventually be repurposed for the benefit of the community. The future use of the Net Factory site is still in development.
3. Improving Working Waterfront, which includes improving the "Fish Plant" commercial boat launch (44.045297, -68.837313) and repairing/replacing the bulkheads along the "Fish Plant" parking lot (44.045019, -68.837577), which is located adjacent to the Fish Plant commercial boat launch on West Main Street. The purpose of the renovation is to build resilience to the impacts of sea level rise and increased precipitation and to support the commercial fishing economy.

For the Proposed Action, NBRC has determined that the Proposed Action is located within the FFRMS floodplain and warrants an analysis under the 8-Step Decision-Making Process.

This notice provides people who may be affected by the Proposed Action and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information. Commenters are encouraged to offer alternative sites, alternative methods to serve the same project purpose, and methods to minimize and mitigate impacts.

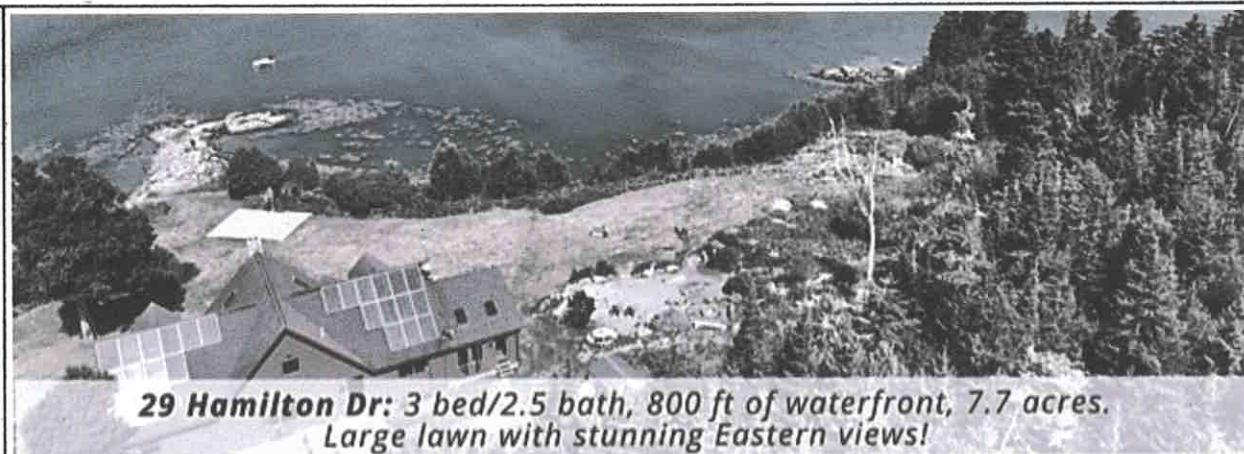

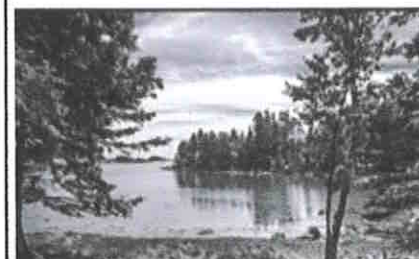

Mr. & Mrs. Keith Kittredge and daughter Pamela of Chatham, Mass., are visiting his parents Mr. & Mrs. Ned Kittredge. *Sept. 14, 1950*

Master Warren Beggs of Atlantic Ave. was just coming out of H. W. Smith's grocery store Wednesday a little before noon when he recognized the local reporter and gave this bit of news: "I'm going to school this afternoon," and he proudly called attention to the fine new long lead pencil with the eraser at the end and the pad he had just purchased with its picture of three bears on the cover. Fearing the item was not firmly impressed in the writer's mind he repeated it, emphasizing the fact with a look of joyous anticipation. "How fine! Well, I know you will have a happy time there at school," was remarked. "Yes, I think I will too," said Warren, and he crossed the road to his home with big visions of his first day at school beckoning him on in the quest of knowledge. *Sept. 10, 1915*

A son, Robert Richard, was born Sept. 4 to Mr. and Mrs. Richard Walker at the Sukeforth Maternity Home. *Sept. 9, 1950*

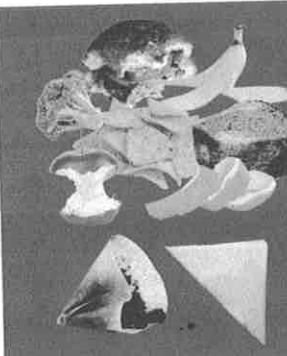

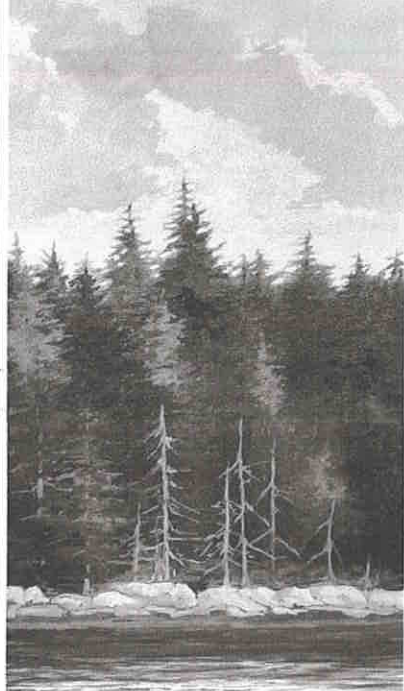

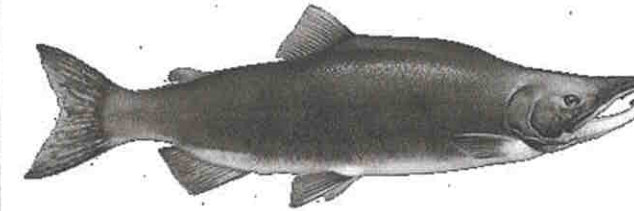

Vis for Vinalhaven Debating and Literary Association.

"On the evening of March 16th, 1883, a number of gentlemen met in the Good Templar Hall Vinalhaven, to consider the propriety of forming a Debating Club or Literary Association in the above-named town." Not much is known about this society other than what was documented in a ledger found in the museum archives. Their first topic of debate was "That of the Admission of Ladies as members would be beneficial to the association." The membership list has over 100 names, and it appears the initiation fee for gentlemen was 50¢, and 25¢ for ladies. In this ledger, minutes of meetings are only recorded until February 7, 1884, but dues logged in later pages are dated until May 1, 1891.

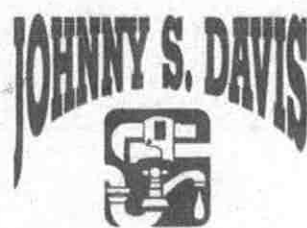

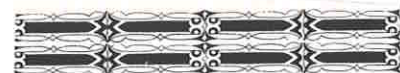
