

2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

2021-2022 Property Taxes – Tax Liens will be filed this week at the Knox County Registry of Deeds for all 2021-2022 unpaid balances. Property owners with liens have 18 months to pay off the taxes or automatic foreclosure will occur as required by state law.

Dog Licenses – All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$1 I for male/female. A new puppy must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving puppies/dogs if these guidelines are followed. All dogs not licensed for 2022 now have to pay \$25 late fee per dog.







The Observer

I am from Away. This is

painful for me to acknowledge but, in the long run, probably therapeutic. My great-great-great, grandfather Thaddeus Carver landed here on Vinalhaven Island among other early settlers in 1766. He married Sarah Hall from Matinicus Island, a variation of Away but not as bad as, say, Worcester. They raised 10 kids. One of them was my great-great, grandmother Lydia. Lydia married Otis Shaw & they had 9 children including my great-great, grandmother Jane Shaw. Jane married James Roberts & they had Hannibal Hamlin Roberts, who married Aura Marcella Coombs & fathered Rena, my great grandmother. Rena & Bert Shields had my grandmother Phillis & there the trouble began. When she was 16, a crewman on the old Governor Bodwell swept her off her feet. They remained aloft for 65 years but early on, after Mom was born here on the island, they had the bad form to move briefly to Mass. where she grew up, married a local man & although I insisted on being born on the island, she delivered me & my brother there in Quincy. We moved back here in 48; I was 4 but it was too late. That's why I have an accent.




