CHANGES AT THE TRANSFER STATION

Effective Sunday, April 12, 2020, some changes are being implemented at the Transfer Station concerning social distancing and how we make payments. The changes are being made to protect employees and customers while still continuing to provide as many of the Transfer Station services as possible.

Social Distancing

Customers MUST maintain a minimum distance of six feet from anyone at the Transfer Station. It is recommended that you wear a facial covering, such as a mask or bandana, especially if you have to talk to the attendant. The attendants will be wearing a face covering when they talk with us.

We are asked to limit our time at the station. Many of us often enjoy a chat with someone we run into there, but now, as we practice social distancing elsewhere, we must not make the Transfer Station an exception to that practice.

If you need to pay for your trash, please line up at the door, no closer than six feet to the next person in line.

Payments

You can order stickers by calling the Town Office at **207-863-4343** or email townclerk@townofvinalhaven.org.

For other payments, the preferred method is to use an account. Accounts have been used by construction crews, lobstermen, and other businesses for a long time. Individual homeowners with not much trash can also have an account. You simply request one (at the Transfer Station or by calling the Town Office) and put some money on it, and when you have worked the account down to zero, you add more to it. The Town will send you an invoice if you are not keeping track of your balance.

If you pay with cash, no change will be given. The change due to you will be credited to your account, and if you don't have an account the attendant will start one for you.
