NEW CASES REPORTED

Five (5) known positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported to ICMS and the Public Health Team in the last three weeks. Keep in mind that the Public Health Team is notified only of positive tests that are conducted by ICMS. The Public Health Team is not notified of positive tests conducted off-island. Therefore, be aware that the numbers we report are KNOWN confirmed cases only and may not represent the actual number of individuals on-island who have tested positive for COVID-19.

VINALHAVEN SCHOOL UPDATE

Hello parents and students,

Due to concerns regarding positive COVID cases on Vinalhaven, the school is taking important precautions to prevent further spread within the school and community.

On Monday and Tuesday, we will not have school as teachers prepare for remote instruction. We will have remote instruction on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
