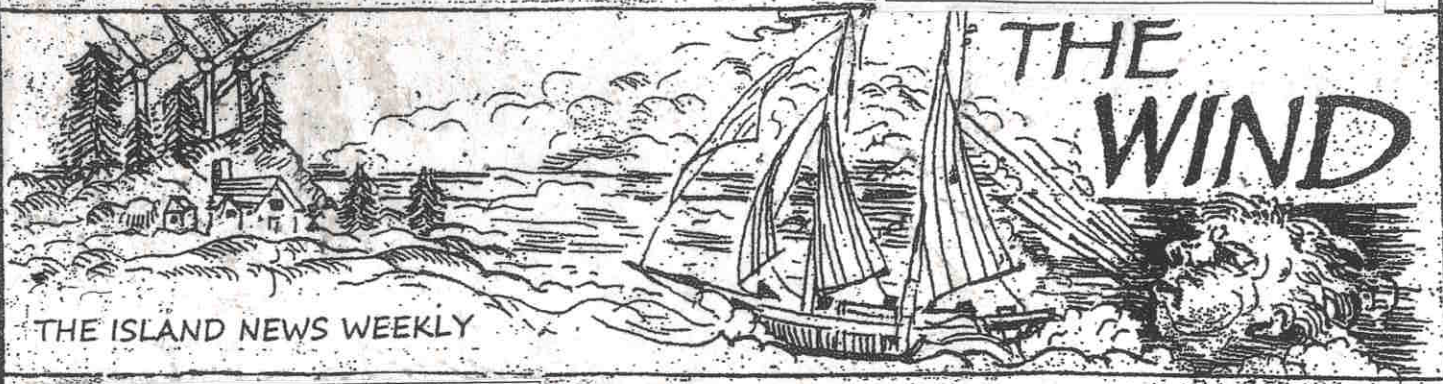

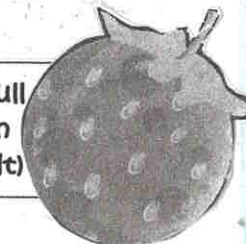

2022-2023 Property Taxes - Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue starting November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

Dog Licenses - \$25 late fee is now in place for all unregistered dogs. All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new dog must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving dogs to Vinalhaven if these guidelines are followed.

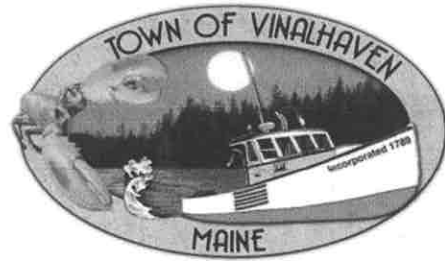

Barbara Ann Davidson, 78, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 11, 2022 at Windward Gardens in Camden.

Born on December 31, 1944, on Vinalhaven, the daughter of Edward Turner White and Lily Anderson White. One of two children, she attended local schools, Barb grew up in the same house as her grandmother Hannah Anderson, a Swedish immigrant, along with her parents and her brother, Walter. She grew up an island girl and her heart was always on the island, no matter where she was.

In 1963, Barb married the love of her life, Cy Davidson. They raised their three children. On April 8, 1987, Cy and Barb opened their own grocery store, Carver's Harbor Market. Together, they owned and operated the store for many years and to this day the market is still going strong. Barb and Cy were loved by the year-round residents, the summer residents, and their numerous friends from around the world.

Barb was acclaimed for being a kindhearted and loving woman who was most generous to those around her. She was strong and determined to be the best person she could be for her family and her community. Being quick-witted and smart, she was known for having a spitfire personality, but also for being warm and kind. Barb was a true community leader and will be missed by all who knew her.

Family was of the utmost importance to Barb. She was a devoted mother and grandmother. You could always find Barb at one of her children's events in various roles, whether that was acting as a Girl Scout leader, Cub Scout leader or even as a basketball coach. Barb had a special love for watching any baseball game. She was always there for her children.

Barb enjoyed family camping trips during the summer with her family. She also loved traveling, especially to Aruba, where she frequented the beaches and casinos. She loved to gamble and was always very lucky. She and Cy returned to Aruba for many years and just like any place they went they always made many friends along the way. Though they travelled many years by themselves, they also loved to go with all three of their children. Famed for her extremely fun New Year's Eve parties, which happened to double as her birthday, there was always delicious food, live music, and dancing. She was notorious for making a very potent eggnog that was always served on Community Night; refills were very popular amongst the crowd. The Davidson household was a home for their kids, but always welcomed anyone, making all who entered feel like family. It was a house filled with life and consistently entertaining.

Barb was the pillar of her community. She served on the Select Board, School Board, Vinalhaven Chamber of Commerce, Fox Island Concerts, and was a founding member of Partners in Island Education, among other things. Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

At Lincoln School Mrs. Josephine Hopkins gave an interesting talk to the pupils of 6, 7, and 8th grades, with teachers, Dorothy Meline and Isabel Calderwood. Mrs. Hopkin's subject was "Iceland," where she served as Army Nurse in WWII. *June 6, 1950*

In the Bodwell Granite Co. office is a picture of the new Washington, D.C. post office which is being cut by the company's Vinalhaven crew. It is a magnificent structure. The company has the contract from the basement to the roof of the loftiest tower. To give some idea of the size of the contract, Rockland's substantial custom house and post office contains 15,000 cubic feet of granite, now appreciate the fact that the Washington structure will contain 300,000 cubic feet and that the company has only two years in which to complete the job. *June 5, 1894*

Don't forget the entertainment "Mother Goose Island" at Town Hall tonight given by the 6th & 7th grade pupils of Lincoln School. *June 1, 1917*

Robert Cassie, son of Mrs. Mary Cassie, who has been, and is now in the trenches and at the front in France, is the first VH boy to receive a War Medal for Bravery *June 21, 1918*

Hard wood sold here last week for \$4 a cord. *June 7, 1892*

F. Bruce Grindle who has been associated for 3 years with the Prince George Hotel in New York, has taken the management of the Lane's Island House, so-called, and is to open it for a summer hotel. This house has been remodeled, refurnished, has electric lights, baths, fireplaces and a heating plant. Every room has a wonderful ocean view. The season opens July 1st and closes Oct. 1st. *June 9, 1928*

Landlocked salmon were seen flapping in Old Harbor Pond Friday evening. About 20 years ago Moses Webster put 5000 in the pond and no one has ever fish for them. *June 4, 1895*

W. H. Lawry recently sold a cow to Capt. E. J. Hopkins that in a 7 day test produced 17 lbs. 14 oz. of butter. *June 24, 1919*

Eighty-eight years ago (June 8, 1935) the USS Castine was wrecked.

Mr. & Mrs. Ted MacDonald and daughters Olga and Edith have moved from Granite Island to their home on High Street. *June 27, 1944*
