Ingredients

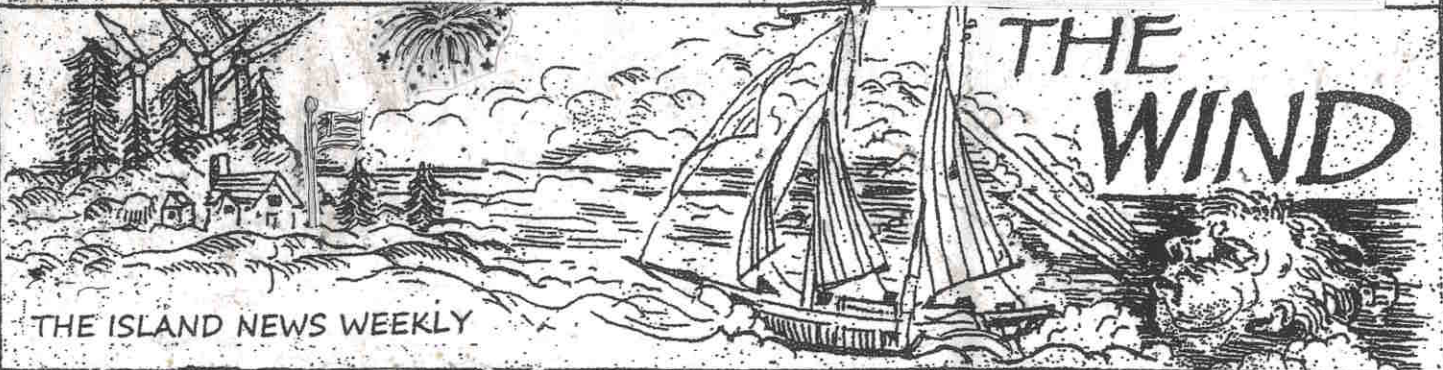
- 1 large onion, thin sliced rings

2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue starting November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

Dog Licenses – \$25 late fee is now in place for all unregistered dogs. All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new dog must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving dogs to Vinalhaven if these guidelines are followed.

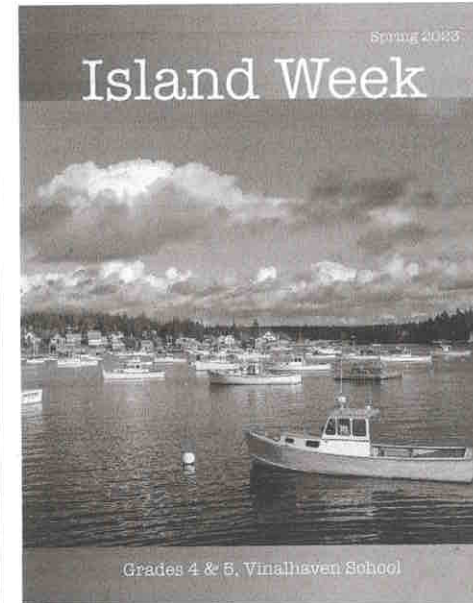


Hot off the presses! Island Week

Tidbits from the Vinalhaven Historical Society

Monday night at the close of the regular meeting of Marguerite Chapter O. E. S., the entertainment committee presented a very fine program: As the pianist Leola Smith played the wedding march, wedding gowns were modeled by the following members: No. 1- Marion Calderwood wore the wedding gown of her grandmother, Mrs. Ivory Littlefield, who was married in 1869. The material was brown silk, purchased in France. No. 2- Patricia Crossman entered wearing a white lace wedding gown with a long train of the 30's. No. 3- Margaret Chilles wore a 40's gown of white satin. No. 4- Helen Poole wore a white wedding gown of the 50's. All modeled the gowns in a very graceful manner. Refreshments were served. *June 7, 1951*

Paulel and Francis Flagg and James McGrath are at the Flagg Estate at Roberts Harbor for the summer. Other members of the Flagg family arrive next week. *June 28, 1941*

James Webster, son of Mr. & Mrs. Charles W. Webster, celebrated his 10th birthday at his home. Games were played and lunch was served on the lawn. The young host received many gifts. Those present were Charlotte & Constance Webster, William & Lucille Bruce, Rebecca & Junior Duncan, Ruth, David & Leroy Crebbs, Earl Hamilton, Ruth & Charles Wadsworth, Alton & Marion Oakes, Dorothy Conway, Bertil Cedarburg, Charles, Alex & Madeline Newbold, Marion Webb, Henry Ewell, Eiflyn Roberts, and Malcolm Whittington, Mrs. Agnes Oakes and Mrs. Basil Webster assisted in serving. *June 30, 1931*

An old-fashioned spelling bee held at the Grange Hall proved a very interesting. Many who announce their intention of spelling were too timid to stand in line when the evening of the contest arrived. An attempt was made at choosing sides, with Mrs. R. F. Green and Mrs. Daniel Gross as leaders, but this was given up and the spelling went on in turn. A slight mistake in pronunciation, which was not corrected, sent some of the good spellers out early, the word "beneficiaries" was not spelled correctly by anyone so that all who went out on this were called again into line. Mrs. Winnie Burgess Ames, Benjamin Myrick, Mrs. R. F. Green and Miss Albra Gross spelled for a long time, then the contest was between Miss Gross and Mrs. Green, who continued for several minutes. Mrs. Green was the winner and was presented with a handsome gold lined silver cup presented by Daniel Gross, Master of Pleasant River Grange in Vinalhaven. The services of the Terpsichorean Orchestra added much to the pleasure of the evening. The sale of ice cream and cake and dancing followed the spelling bee. *June 22, 1912*

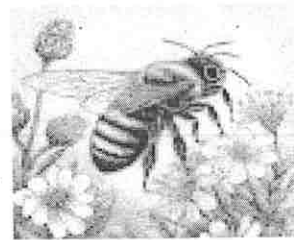
