

2022-2023 Property Taxes – Tax bills were mailed out on September 8, 2022. Tax bills were sent to the owner of record on April 1, 2022. If you sold your property after April 1, 2022, it's up to you to forward the tax bill to the new owner. Payments are due on November 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023. Interest will accrue starting November 2, 2022 and May 2, 2023. Please call the Town Office at 863-4471 or 863-4343 if you have any questions.

Dog Licenses – \$25 late fee is now in place for all unregistered dogs. All dogs 6 months or older need to be licensed, including visiting dogs in town for 10 days or more. Please bring current rabies certificate and \$6 for spayed/neutered or \$11 for male/female. A new dog must be vaccinated & licensed once reaching 6 months of age, and if adopting an older dog or if you are just arriving in town, you have ten days to register. There is no late fee for new or newly arriving dogs to Vinalhaven if these guidelines are followed.

June 29, 1948







Lorraine's Rhubarb Upside Down Cake

Ingredients

3 C sliced fresh or frozen rhubarb

1 C sugar

2 Tblsp all-purpose flour 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg

1/4 C butter, melted

Batter

1/4 C butter, melted

3/4 C sugar

1 large egg, room temperature

1-1/2 C all-purpose flour

2 tsp baking powder

½ tsp ground nutmeg

1/4 tsp salt

2/3 C cup 2% milk

Sweetened whipped cream, optional

Directions

1 Place rhubarb in a greased 10-in. cast-iron or other heavy ovenproof skillet. Combine sugar, flour and nutmeg, sprinkle over rhubarb. Drizzle with butter. For batter, in a large bowl, beat the butter & sugar until blended. Beat in the egg. Combine the flour, baking powder, nutmeg & salt. Gradually add to egg mixture alternately with milk, beating well after each addition.

2 Spread over rhubarb. Bake at 350° until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, about 35 min. Loosen edge immediately and invert onto serving dish. Served warm. If desired, served with whipped cream



THE OBSERVER

I was always a Red Sox fan as a kid. Frank Malzone, Jimmy Pearsall, Ted Williams; these guys and their heroics were topics of conversation in our family for years. I remained a fan until the 94/95 players strike. The injury I felt at having the entire post season cancelled and the selfishness I perceived in that travesty took the winds of enthusiasm out of my sails and I never watched again until a few years ago when, inexplicably, my wife, took vigorous interest in the Red Sox and for a few years then we hardly missed a game. The only interruption in her otherwise unrelenting support for the team revolved around spitting. The players and managers are like camels. minus the dromedary's pinpoint accuracy. I recall we watched Daniel Nava in his first appearance at bat. Although not spitting at all, he hit the first pitch he'd every seen in the big leagues for a grand slam home run. Then, after having been playing for nearly a month, and, in the interest of team spirit, he began to spit. At first it just dribbled down his chin, typical of a rookie, but soon most of his expulsions were big league projectiles, falling within the broad arc of acceptability that defines that soggy area around home plate. A few days later, when Pedreoia singled in the bottom of the ninth, Nava, with the winning run slid into home on his face. the skids having been greased so to speak by his own saliva and that of his peers.

Baader-Meinhof Phenomenon
