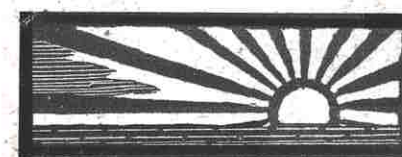

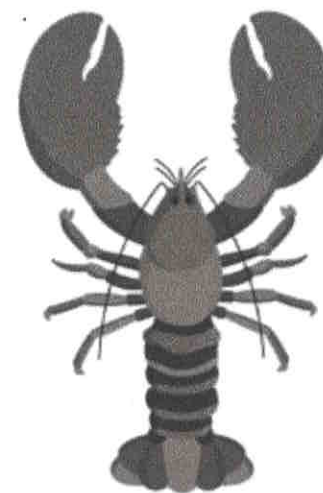

**Mrs. Keith Carver** entertained Friday at a "Woodshed Party." One table of bridge was at play. Lunch was served. Her guests were Mrs. Max Conway, Mrs. Herbert Morton and Miss Muriel Chilles. *Sept. 5, 1944*

**Miss Edith MacDonald**, Miss Patricia Skoog, Herbert Peterson and David Duncan, Jr., enjoyed a steak dinner at the Ames Farm, Calderwood's Neck. *Sept. 24, 1949*

**The annual boatmen's race** was held last Tuesday. It was a perfect day for the race, a good breeze blowing. The white winged dinghies looked so pretty as they flew along. This race is looked forward to each year and much depends on not only knowing how to handle a sail boat, but upon good judgment. James A. Lewis won the race this year, a purse of \$15 and a box of cigars was the prize. *Sept. 7, 1922*

**The Birthday Club** met Friday for a dinner party at *The Islander* honoring the birthdays of Mrs. Leola Smith and Mrs. Louise Anderson. The table was attractive with corsages of gladioli at each place and a delightful dinner was served at the end of which a beautifully decorated birthday cake, made by Mrs. Mae Brown and the gift of Mrs. Helen Arey, was presented to the honored guests. After dinner the members were entertained in the music room with piano and vocal solos by Mrs. Leon Arey and Arthur Brown. Later the Club went to the home of Mrs. Mae Tolman for a social evening and the opening of gifts. *Sept. 12, 1950*

## Old Reuben

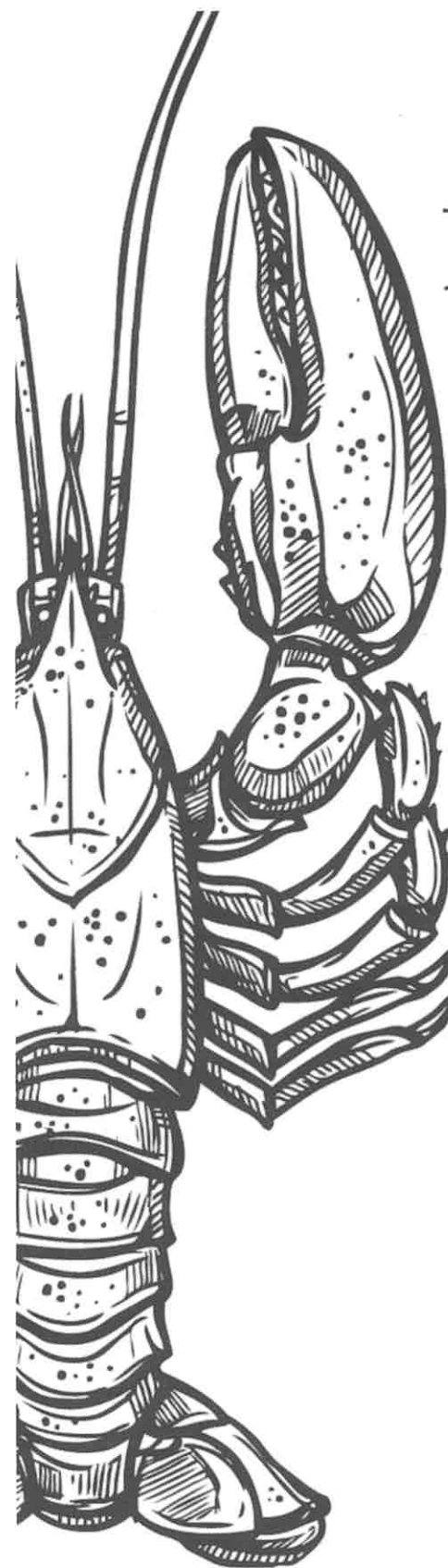
The first time I saw Old Reuben was about 20 years ago when it was being pulled by a lowly Jeep in the annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. I thought how demeaning this must be for this magnificent nineteenth century fire engine. It should be pulled by a team of handsome fire horses.

So, when the new EMS Building was built, I discussed giving Old Reuben a proper tribute by painting a mural to be placed over the EMS building doors. It would depict Old Reuben rushing to a fire pulled by handsome horses and accompanied by running firemen and even a barking dog. I felt Old Reuben would then be rightfully shown and perhaps the town might find those matching horses for some future July 4<sup>th</sup> parade.

One day not long thereafter an old time Islander stopped me in front of the post office with the news that I had got it completely wrong. He said this type of engine was pulled by a team of fire horses in other places but not on Vinalhaven where it was pulled by a team of volunteer firemen.

The paint is fading, and a couple of small cracks are showing on the mural. It makes me wonder if some day an island artist will want to restore it. If they do I hope, they will replace the horses with those volunteer firemen.
