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Information for applicants:

1. Include copies of any other permits that were obtained regarding this work.
2. Applicant must show the location of all subsurface sewage disposal systems within 200 feet of the proposed well, including those located on adjacent properties.
3. Realizing that when drilled, the actual location of the well on the property might differ from what is proposed, the applicant should show the **minimum** distances between the proposed well and property setbacks & distances from subsurface sewage disposal systems. Approval of the application is conditional upon conforming to these distances; the applicant should revise the application if it is not possible to conform to what is submitted.
4. The applicant may show any dimension or distance greater than 200 ft. as >200 ft. or 200+ ft.
5. The approved/disapproved application will be mailed to the applicant, or a copy may be obtained at the CEO office. No well drilling may begin until the applicant has received an approved permit.
6. Please contact the CEO if you need assistance in obtaining the information needed to complete this application.
