

Meeting Minutes 6/19/2017

In Attendance: Anna Poe, Amy Lear, Gabe McPhail, Pat Lundholm

- 1. ONE more trip to transfer station, Sunday, 7:30. Following that, a walk around with Kenny to look at current layout, possible efficiencies, and make a sign plan.
- 2. Amy will put some clips together to run before Town Meeting, where there is a captive audience. (Andy did not permit it; probably should have run it by him ahead of time).
- 3. Informal survey at the dump. Marketing @ 4th of July (Land Trust table???), flea markets
- 4. Conversation with Mark King: We don't have a perfect answer for him, so we would like to turn the tables and find out from him what we need to have to compost in multiple ways, such as:
 - a. What kind/mix/volume do we need to take meat, bones, fat?
 - b. What kind/mix/volume do we need to take chipped wood? (will we always have a burn pile?)
 - c. What kind/mix/volume do we need to make it economical to do the faster composting
 - *d*. Will our summer/winter volume fluctuations make it smart to have two different kinds (turn on fast in June, for example, and off in October).
 - e. If the town makes compost, can it be used anywhere?
- 5. In the next two weeks, visit the following food producers with Anna's letter layout to see willingness to participate or consider participating or already composting:
 - a. Anna: Sand Bar, Surfside, Salt
 - b. Gabe: Gawker, Haven
 - *c.* Pat: Carvers, Eldercare, ICMS, Apartments, Fisherman's Friend (probably no food prep or trash to speak of at the Friend and ICMS)
 - d. Amy: School, Pizza Pitt
